

Columbia County N.Y.

At a Court of General Sessions  
of the Peace held at Ele. by in and  
for said County on 17. June A. D. 1876  
before Hon. John Dean Pres. at Judge  
And Res. John Lloyd and John Blanagan  
Associate Judges.

The petition of divers citizens of Blackstock  
township in said County was presented. Representing  
that a Public Road was long since laid out leading  
from the Clay pits in Polesome to a public road  
on land now owned by Reuben Poring. That a part  
of said road commencing at the public road  
on land of said Poring and ending within said  
road enters to the public road leading from the  
'White Hill' to Susquehanna has never been opened for  
public use. That to open said road would require  
the expenditure of a large amount of money and the  
erection of a Bridge over Blackstock Creek R.  
That said Road is now needed for public use,  
and if opened would be burdensome in cost  
and useless. And that pray of the Court to  
appoint Commissioners to vacate the same.

The Court upon due consideration do  
order and appoint Henry Scalow Esq., William  
Bracken and John B. Stets Commissioners who, after  
having been first duly sworn and aff'd to  
accede to law to discharge the duties of

this appointment with fidelity as to go upon the  
ground on which said mad has been treated.

And if all of them view the same and a majority  
of them agree the said mad is unwell in mind and  
hence some, the Jhee. Co reports to the West Coast  
of Quater Sessions. Accompanying this report  
with a plan or draft of the part of said mad  
which the same paper Jhee. Co treated.
