

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions
of the Peace of the County of Cambria:

The petition of the undersigned, respectfully represents: That
a public road, beginning in a public road from Ebensburg to
Buck's Mill, at or near the barn on the farm of the heirs of Wm.
Kaylor, deceased, and ending in the public road from Ebensburg
to Loretto, at the Red School House, in Allegheny Township, laid out
by order of this Court, and duly confirmed ~~many~~ years ago; and that
said road has become inconvenient in a part of its present lo-
cation, and would better accommodate the public travel by being
changed so as to begin in the said public road leading from
Ebensburg to Buck's Mill, at a cherry tree near the house of the
said heirs of Wm. Kaylor, deceased, in Allegheny Township, and
to run thence in a direct line to and intersect the said road
as laid out aforesaid at about Two hundred and ten yards,
(210) at or near a cherry tree, leaving the road to end at the Red
School House as it at present does.

The petitioners therefore pray the Court to inquire of and
change the said road, and for that purpose to appoint three
persons, qualified according to law, to view the said road and
the ground proposed for the said change, and inquire of the
premises and make report of their proceedings at the next term

of said Court. And they will ever pray, &c.
