merset County, Humbly Represent; That
we have heretofore labored under great in-
convenience for want of a level road from
Bens Creek to Johnstown; That to avoid
travelling over a very steep hill, very steep
both going to and returning from Johnstown,
our only market within reach; We have
voluntarily opened that part of a Township
Road leading from Bens Creek down Sto-
my Creek via E. A. Vickroy's to the end of
George W. Osborn's lane; between Bens Creek
and E. A. Vickroy's, without any cost to the
tax payers of Godersdownship. We are infor-
med that certain Citizens have petitioned
your Honors to vacate that portion of the
Road that we have been at so much la-
bor to open. We therefore, relying on the
justice and equity of our claims to be heard,
Humbly pray your Honors not to vacate
said Road.
