

Amherst County ss;

At a Court of General Quarter Sessions
of the Peace held at Ebensburg in and
for said County on the seventh day
of February A. D. 1844; before the
Hon. John Dean President and John Blanagan
and John A. Huskins Esqrs. Assists Judges.

The Petition of citizens of Black R. Township
in said County was presented setting forth that
they labor under great inconvenience for want of
a Public Road to begin in the Public road
about one quarter of a mile from the house of
Charles Parabagh in the road leading from Huncams
Mills to St. Nicholas, and thence to lead to the bridge
road running from Huncams Mills to Cherry Tree
at a point between James Burnett and Reuben Boing
Jr., in Black R. Township in said County.

And therefore praying the Court to appoint
suitable persons to view and lay out said road.

The Court upon due consideration had of
the premises do order and appoint James Reed
John Cannon and Henry Scalan to view the
ground proposed for said road, who, after first
having been duly sworn or affirmed to discharge
the duties of their appointment with fidelity shall
proceed to view the same and if a majority of the
views agree that there is occasion for such

Road they shall proceed to lay out the same as agreeably to the wishes of the petitioners as may be having respect to the best ground for a road and the shortest distance and in such manner as to do the least injury to private property.

The persons interested in said Road may frequently give public Notice by printed or written advertisements of the time and place when such Views shall meet for the purpose of locating said Road, at least ten days before such meeting.

If the Views aforesaid shall decide in favor of locating said road, it is hereby made their duty to obtain from the persons through whom said Road may pass releases from any damages that may arise to them in opening the same.

And in every case when the Owners of such lands refuse releasing their claim to damages, the said Views shall assess the damages, and make report thereof signed by a majority of the Views present, and transmit the same together together with all releases to the next Court of Quarter Sessions who shall file with the papers relating to said Road.

And the said Views shall make reports of their proceedings hereinto the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, accompanying the same with a Plan or Draft of said road with reference to the improvements

In obedience to the aforesaid order of a Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, at June Term A.D. 1877 We the undersigned do report that we met at time and place appointed and designated in public notices posted in public places ten days before meeting a copy whereof is hereto attached and after first being duly sworn and affirmed according to law did view, mark and lay out the following for a public road or highway viz Beginning at a fork and Township road leading to Clay Fork on line of land of James Barnett and Robert Boring thence by said line of land South Eighty seven and one half degrees East one hundred and eighty four perches thence South sixty two degrees East thirty eight perches thence South thirty eight and one half degrees East eighteen perches thence South fifty and one half degrees East eighty four perches to said Township road leading from St. Nicholas to Suncous Mills on land of John Harris all of which is respectfully submitted
