

Cambria County, Ill.

At a Court of General Quarter Sessions of the
Peace held at Ebenburg in and for the County
of Cambria on the seventh day of April A.D.
1881. before the Honorable Judges of the said
Court

The petition of sundry citizens Bar and Susquehanna
and Townships in said County was presented repre-
senting that they labor under great inconvenience
for want of a public road or highway to lead from
a point on Indiana and Cambria County line on
farm of Sarah Callincey to a point on Township
road leading from Adam Keith's Sr. to Garman's
Mills at or near farm of Abraham De Haven in
Susquehanna Township. praying the Court to
appoint proper persons to view and lay out the
same. The Court upon due consideration had
of the premises do order and appoint Peter Garman,
Abraham De Haven and Henry Scanlan to view
the ground proposed for said road who after having
first given due and legal notice of the time and
place of meeting by printed or written advertisements
and having been duly qualified according to law
to discharge the duties of their appointment with
fidelity shall proceed to view the same and if all
the said viewers view the same and a majority of
them agree that there is occasion for said road
they shall proceed to view and lay out the same as
agreeably to the wishes of the petitioners as may

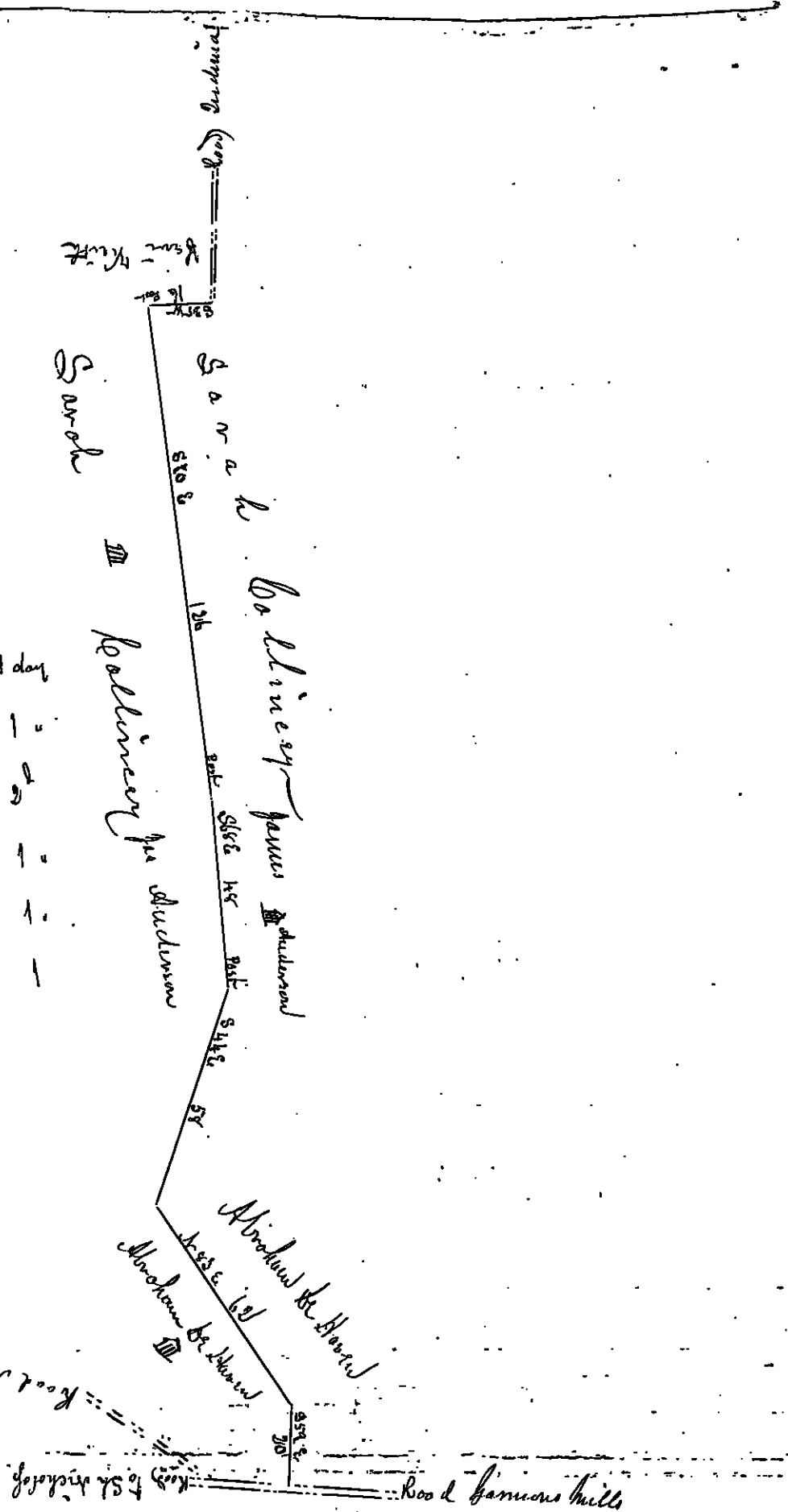
be having respect to the best ground for a road and the shortest distance and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property.

If the viewers shall decide in favor of locating said road it is hereby made their duty to obtain from the persons through whose lands the road may pass releases from any damages that may accrue to them from opening the same, and in every case where the owners of such land refuse releasing their claims for damages, the said viewers shall assess the damages, if any, and make report thereof signed by a majority of the viewers present and transmit the same together with all releases to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be filed with the papers relating to said road. And the said viewers shall make report of their proceedings herein to the next Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace to be held for said County accompanying the same with a plot or draft of said road the courses and distances and reference to the improvements through which the same passes. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed, and also whether they judge the said road necessary for a public or private road.

We the undersigned Viewers appointed by the aforesaid
Order of Court do report that we gave due and timely
notice of time and place of meeting by written notices posted
in public places in Susquehanna Township And the Viewers
having met at time and place appointed by said notices
and after being all sworn and affirmed according to law
we proceeded to the duties of our appointment and did
view mark and lay out the same for a public road or
highway being beginning at the terminus of a Public road
leading from County line of Indiana and Cambria Counties to
Indiana on land of Sarah Callincey thence South twenty five
degrees West sixteen perches Post thence South seventy degrees
East one hundred and twenty six perches Post thence South sixty
eight degrees East forty eight perches Post thence South forty four
degrees East fifty eight perches Post thence North eighty three deg
rees East sixty two perches to line of land thence South fifty nine
degrees East at twenty perches to a Point on public road leading
from Adam Keiths to Samsons Mills near farm of A B Haven
all of said viewed and laid out road being in Susquehanna Township
Cambria County And we further do award and assess a
damage to the following persons whose improved land said
road is located on to Sarah Callincey we believe the road to be
of more benefit to her farm than a damage to James Anderson
twenty four dollars to Abraham B Haven we award thirty dollar

1st The said report is illegal and erroneous, because
the road proposed to be made passes through
the land of one of the viewers to wit, Abraham
De Haven,

2. The report of the said viewers is partial, illegal
and erroneous, for the reason, damages are allotted
in favor of one of the viewers to wit, in favor of
the said Abraham De Haven, while damages are
refused to Sarah Berlinsky, and who sustained
damages to a much greater amount, than the
said viewer.

3rd The said report, is illegal, partial and unfair,
because it refused damages to Sarah Berlinsky, who
will sustain more than \$150. if the said road shall
be opened.
