At a Court of General Quarter Sessions of the Peace held at Ebensburg in and for said County, on the second day of November A. D. 1887 before the Honorable Judges of said Court: The petition of divers citizens of the townships of Blacklick and Jackson in said County was presented, setting forth, that it is necessary that a Bridge should be erected over the Blacklick Creek between said townships at a point between the farms of Mrs. C. Smith and John Davis, where the said Creek crosses the public road leading from the Bethel Church in Blacklick township to the farm of Martin Munday in Jackson township, and that the erecting of said Bridge will require more expense than it is reasonable the said townships should bear, and praying the Court to take such order on the subject as is required by the Act of the General Assembly in such case made and provided.

The Court upon due consideration had of the premises do order and appoint Henry Scudlaw, Rees J. Lloyd and A. J. Rhey to view the place proposed for said Bridge, who after having been duly qualified according to law to discharge the duties of their appointment with fidelity, are to go upon the premises, and inquire whether said bridge is necessary, and whether it would be too expensive for the townships of Blacklick and Jackson to bear the costs of its erection. And make report of their proceedings herein to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County of Columbia.

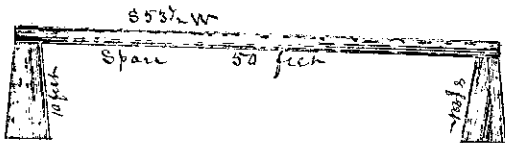
