

Columbia County, Pa.

At a Court of General Quarter Sessions of the Peace held at Ebensburg, in and for said County, on Tuesday the nineteenth day of July A.D. 1881 before the Honorable Judges of said Court:

The petition of divers inhabitants of Allegheny Township in said County was presented, representing that a road was formerly laid out from Bradley School House to Wm. J. Buck's in said Township, and that they are desirous to have that part vacated and supplied extending from the Bradley School House, to intersect the said Old road at lands of George Micks, and praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view, vacate and supply the same according to law. The Court upon due consideration had of the premises do order and appoint Henry Scoulan, Joseph Conduino and Thomas Rosenstiel to view the ground proposed to be vacated and supplied, who after having first given due and legal notice of the time and place of meeting, by printed or written advertisements, and having been duly qualified according to law, to discharge the duties of their appointment with fidelity, shall proceed to view the same, and if all of the said Viewers view the same, and a majority of them agree that there is occasion for said road to be vacated and supplied, they shall proceed to vacate and supply the same as agreeably to the wishes of the petitioners as may be, having respect to the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, and in such manner as to do the least injury to private property.

If the Viewers aforesaid shall decide in favor of vacating and supplying said road, it is hereby made their duty to obtain from the persons through whose lands the road may pass releases from any damages that may accrue to them from opening the same, and in every case where the owners of such lands refuse releasing their claims for damages, the said Viewers shall assess the damages, if any, and make report thereof signed by a majority of the Viewers present, and transmit the same, together with all releases with their report. And the said

Viewers shall make report of their proceedings herein to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County accompanying the same with a plot or draft of said road vacated and supplied, and references to the improvements through which the same passes, in which report they shall state distinctly, that they had been sworn or affirmed, and also, whether they judge the same necessary for a Public or Private Road.

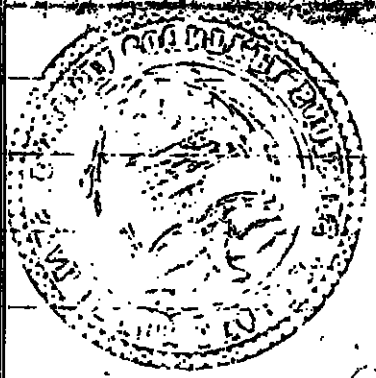

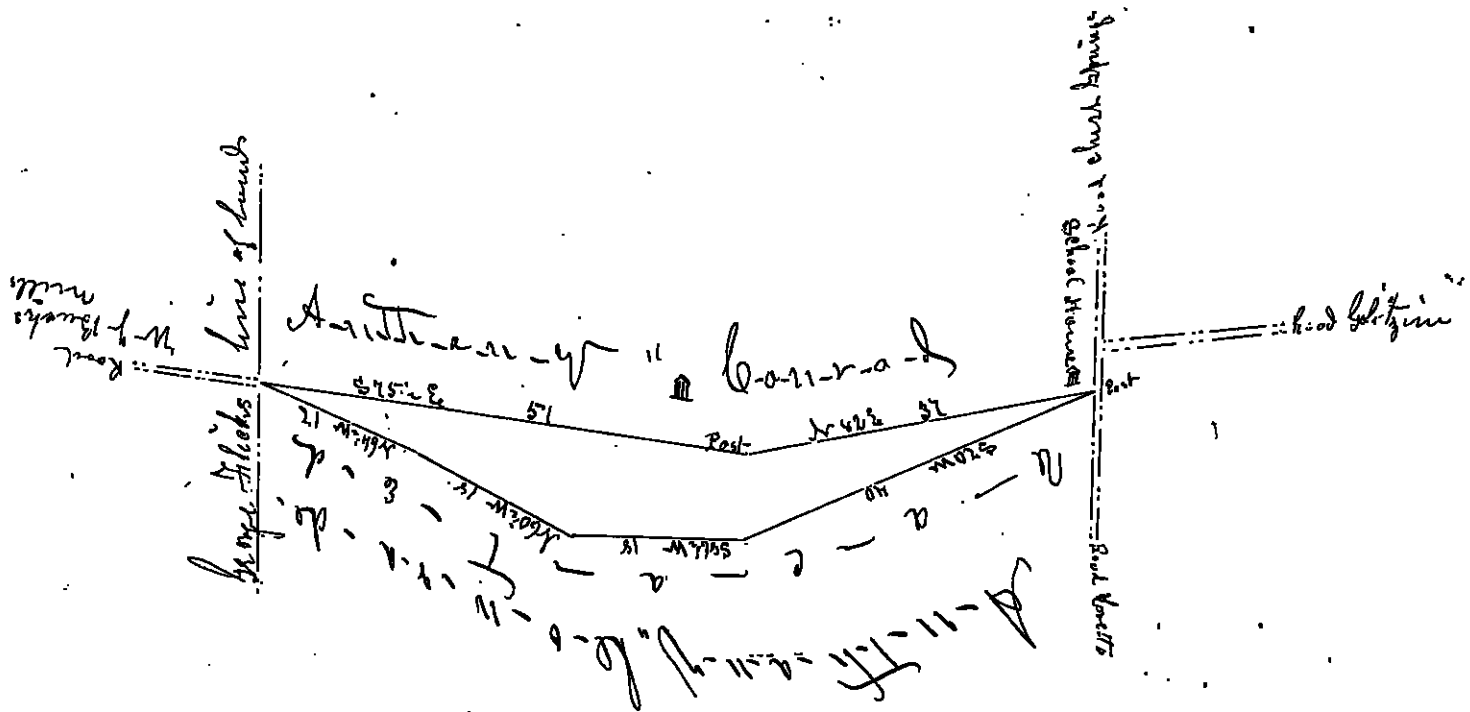

To the Honorable the Judges within Court

We the undersigned Jurors do Report that having given due and timely notice of time and place of view by posting four written notices a copy of which is hereto annexed and further we do report that having met at time and place designated in said notice and after first being all sworn according to law we proceeded to the duties of our appointment and did view and locate the following parts of road mentioned in said Order viz Beginning at a Point on public road leading from Court Street Springs near School House to on land of Anthony Leonard thence South seventy degrees West forty perches thence South eighty six and one half degrees West eighteen perches thence North sixty and one half degrees West eighteen perches thence North sixty four and one half degrees West seventeen perches to a point where large ditch line crosses said road which in our opinion should be located in consequence damaging personal property and can be supplied doing less damage and better site for road And we do supply the same for a public road or high way viz Beginning at point on line of land of George Welch in old road thence South seventy five and one half degrees East fifty one perches to post in field of J. Leonard thence North eighty two degrees East thirty seven perches to post in Court's and Court Springs road in our opinion doing less damage to private property making the road shorter and on better ground for a road all of which is respectfully submitted see draft hereto annexed.
