

Cambria County, ss.

At a Court of the Quarter Sessions of the Peace held at Ebersburg in and for said County on Wednesday the fourteenth day of September A.D. 1881 before the Honorable ~~Judge~~ of said Court. The petition of sundry citizens of Blacklick township in said County was presented, setting forth, that they labor under great inconvenience for want of a public road or highway, to lead from a point at or near Bethel School House No. 2, to a point, on the "Murray Road" at or near where the line between lands of J. Mahan and John Rees crosses said road, in said Township and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. The Court upon due consideration had of the premises do order and appoint Henry Scanlan G. J. Lloyd and Isaac Wifingers to view the ground proposed for said road, who after having first given due and legal notice of the time and place of meeting by printed or written advertisements, and having been duly qualified according to law, to discharge the duties of their appointment with fidelity, shall proceed to view the same, and if a majority of them agree that there is occasion for such a road, they shall proceed to view and lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect to the best ground for such road, and the shortest distance, and in such a manner as to do the least injury to private property; if the viewers shall decide in favor of locating said road, it is hereby made their duty, to obtain from those persons through whose lands the road may pass, releases for any damages that may accrue to them by opening the same; and in every case where the owners of such lands refuse releasing their claims for damages, the said viewers shall assess the

damages, if any, and make report thereof signed by a majority of the Viewers present, and transmit the same, together with all releases, to be filed with the papers relating to said road. And the said Viewers shall make report of their proceedings herein to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, accompanying the same with a plot or draft of said road, the courses and distances, and reference to the improvements through which said road passes: in which report they shall state, that they had been sworn or affirmed according to law, and also, whether they judge said road as laid out necessary for a Public or Private Road

children being a saving of over a mile to said school
