




To The Honorable The Judges of the Court  
of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County

We the Persons appointed by the court to view  
the place proposed for the bridge in the within  
order mentioned, report that being all first sev-  
erally sworn or affirmed according to law and  
having notified the occupiers of the land upon which  
the said bridge is erect of the time of the said view,  
we have viewed the same, and that in our  
opinion there is occasion for the said bridge, and  
that a bridge over the Clearfield Creek at a point  
close above the present ford and marked by us  
on the southeast side of said creek on a pine stump  
is indispensably necessary and that the expenses  
of erecting such a bridge would be attended with  
more cost than the Townships of Dean and Clear-  
field could bear: and that we assess the damages  
to Joseph Dyson & Son, <sup>on whose land the bridge is erected</sup> at one dollar

Report of Grimes  
to view & locate a  
bridge over Clearfork Creek

Cambria County, ss:

At a Court of General Quarter Sessions of the Peace held at Ebensburg in and for said County, on the first day of November A.D. 1881 before the Honorable Judges of said Court, The petition of sundry citizens of the Townships of Clearfield and Dean in said County was presented, representing, that a Bridge is much wanted over Clearfield Creek at the place where the public highway leading from St. Augustine to Altoona crosses the said Creek in said townships. The ford there being frequently rendered impassable by reason of ice and high water, and that the expense of creating said bridge would be too heavy and burdensome upon the inhabitants of said townships: and praying the Court to take such order on the subject as is required by the Act of the General Assembly in such case made and provided.

The Court upon due consideration had of the premises do order and appoint Alexis Will, Dennis Cauley and James Perry, to view the place proposed for said bridge, who after having first been duly qualified by oath or affirmation to discharge the duties of their appointment with fidelity, are to go upon the premises, and inquire whether said bridge is necessary, and whether it would be too expensive for said Townships to bear the costs of its erection; and make report of their proceedings hereon to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County of Cambria.

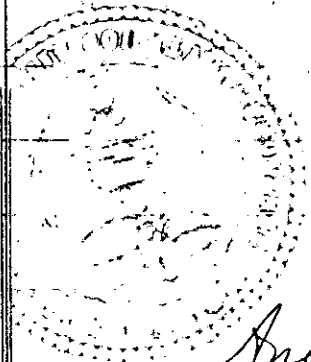
