At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace held at Ebensburg in and for said County, on Tuesday the first day of November A. D. 1881 before the Honorable Judges of said Court:

The petition of the Commissioners of said County was presented, setting forth, that after proceedings duly had in said Court, a Bridge over the Blacklick Creek near Griffiths Mill in Paw Township has been entered as a County Bridge; that after procuring an estimate to be made of the probable expense of the same, they awarded the contract for building it to Michael J. Kirsch for the sum of Five hundred and eighty seven dollars; that they have been notified that the Bridge is now completed, and therefore praying the Court to appoint six disinterested persons to inspect the workmanship of said Bridge and make report thereof according to law.

The Court upon due consideration had of the premises do order, and appoint H. J. Krumanocker, C. McGee, R. D. Williams, Jr., A. Dumm, Geo. A. Krug and J. C. Snyder, who after being respectfully sworn or affirmed according to law, to perform the duties of their appointment with fidelity, are to view the said Bridge and the workmanship thereof, and make report of their proceedings herein to the Judges of said Court at Ebensburg on the first Monday of December next; and in which report they shall state distinctly, that they had been sworn or affirmed according to law.

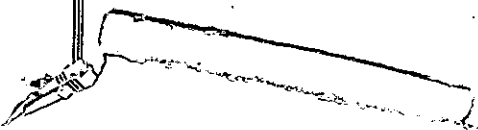
