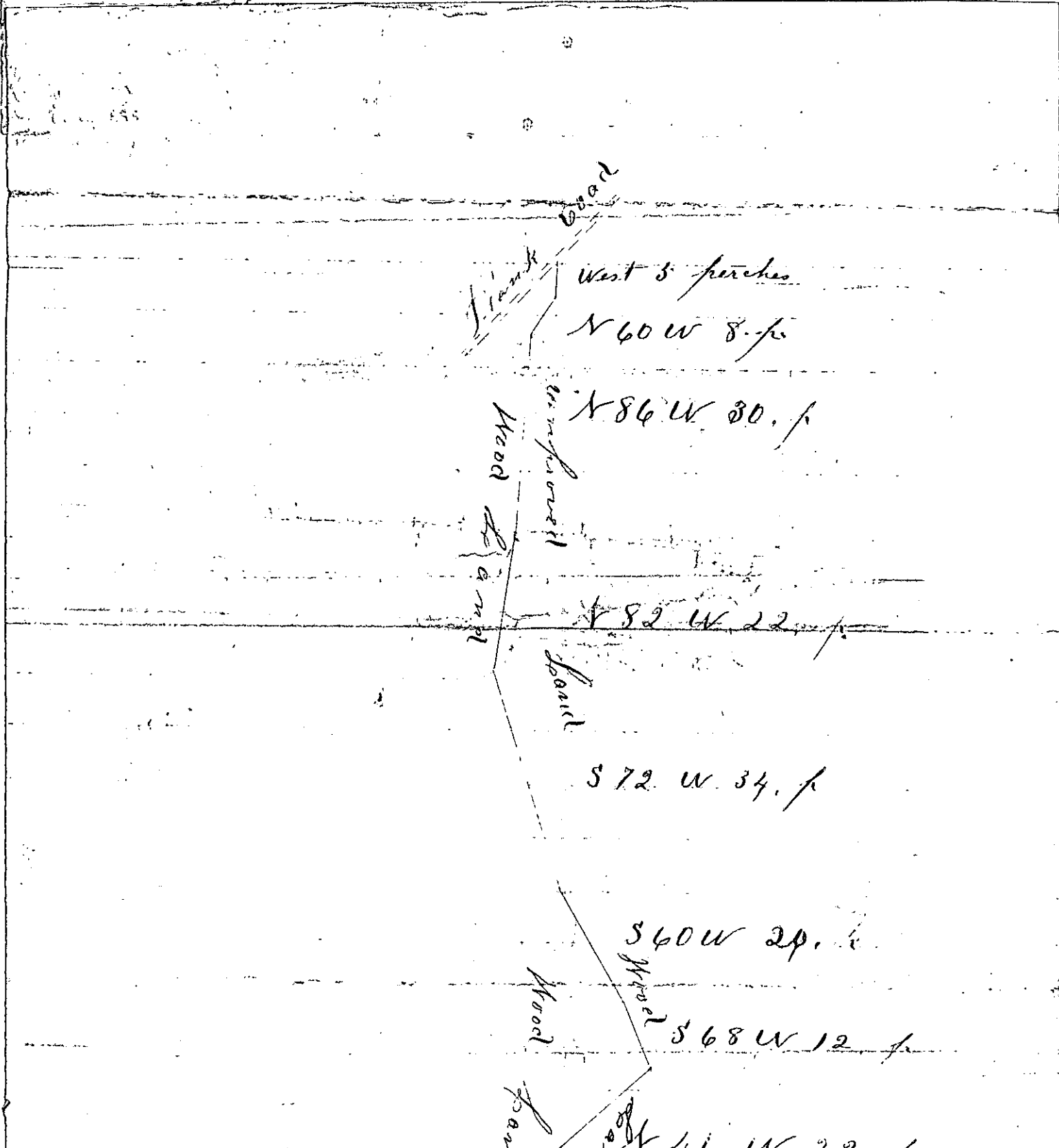


To the Honorable the Judges within Assizes, we
 the persons appointed by the within order of Court
 do report that after being duly sworn according
 to Law and after viewing the premises believe
 there is occasion for said Road we have laid out
 and return for private use the following described
 road viz, Begun at a post at Plank Road near
 the residence of Isaac Jones in Cambria Township
 thence through ^(unimproved) land of Isaac Jones west five perches
 thence North sixty degrees west eight perches to a post thence
 North eighty six degrees west thirty perches to a post thence
 North eighty two degrees west twenty two perches to a post thence
 South seventy two degrees west thirty four perches to a post
 thence through ^(unimproved) land of Roland Francis South sixty degrees
 west twenty perches to a post thence South sixty eight degrees
 west twelve perches to a post thence North forty one degrees
 west twenty two perches thence North seventy one degrees
 west thirty perches to land of Edwin and Thomas Bumford
 near residence of said Bumfords, a draft of which
 is hereto annexed, Witness our hands this 20th day

Report

Know all men by these presents, that I, Isaac D. Jones of the Township of Cambria, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, do by these presents remise, release, quit-claim and for ever discharge any and all claim for damages caused by viewing, laying-out and opening a private road through my lands situate and lying in the Township, County and State aforesaid. The said private road commencing at a point at or near a gate, on the old Plank road leading from Ebensburg to Hilmore, on my premises in the said Township of Cambria, and leading to a point at or near the residence of Thomas and Edwin Bumpford in the Township aforesaid. The view for said private road having been authorized by the Court of Quarter Sessions for the County of Cambria on the fifth day of January A.D. one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one.

At a Court of General Quarter Sessions
of the Peace held at Ebensburg in and
for said County on the fifth day of
January A. D. 1887. Before the Honor-
able Judges of said Court

The petition of Thomas and Edwin Bumpford
of said County was presented representing that
they labor under inconvenience for want of a road
from their dwelling in Cambria Township to a
point on the old plank road leading from Ebens-
burg to Wilmore at or near a gate on the premises
of Isaac D. Jones and praying the Court to
appoint proper persons to view and locate said road
according to law.

The Court upon due consideration of the
premises do order and appoint Wm. E. McConnell
Richard Thomas and Robert W. Roberts to view
the ground proposed for said road who after having
first given due and legal notice by printed or
written advertisements of the time and place of
meeting, and having been duly qualified accord-
ing to law to discharge their appointment with
fidelity, shall proceed to view the same and if
all the said viewers view the same, and a ma-
jority of them agree that there is occasion for
such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same
as agreeably to the wishes of the petitioners as may
be, having respect to the best ground for a road,
and the shortest distance, and in such manner
as to do the least injury to private property.

If the viewers aforesaid, shall decide in favor of locating said road, it is hereby made their duty to obtain from persons through whose land the same may pass, releases from any damages that may accrue to them from opening the same, and in every case when the owners of such land refuse releasing their claim for damages, the said viewers shall assess the damages, if any, and make report thereof signed by a majority of the viewers present, and transmit the same, together with all releases to the next Court of Quarter Sessions, to be filed with the papers relating to said road.

And the said viewers shall make report of their proceedings herein, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, accompanying the same with a plot or draft of said road, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through which the same passes. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed; and also whether they judge said road necessary for a Public or Private road.
