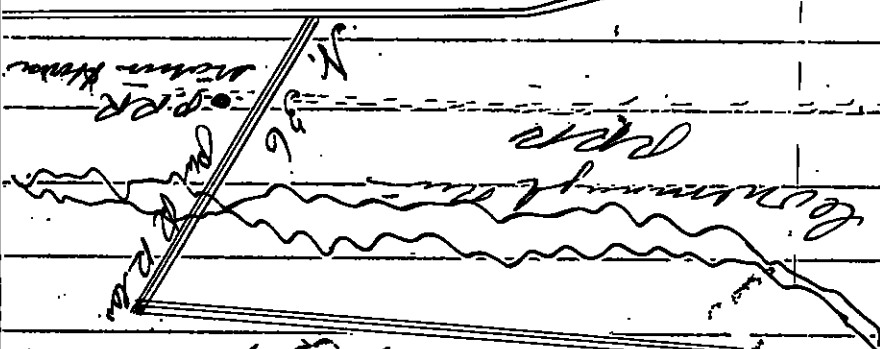

To The Honorable Judges of the Courts of Cambria
County we the persons appointed by an
order of said Court herunto annexed
to view the ground and layout of proposed
Road. Agreeable to said appointment, after
having first given due and legal notice
of the time and place of meeting, and
being duly sworn and affirmed according
to law; do make this our report that we
have viewed the ground and laid out a
road which we believe is necessary for public
use; Draft herunto annexed. Beginning at
a point on the Public road in South Fork thence
North through improved land and across Conmough
Creek Thirty (36) six perches, thence through unim-
proved lands of the Cambria Iron Co. South
Sixty (64) four degrees west Sixty (63) three perches thence
through same North Sixty (65) five degrees west (15)
In fifteen perches thence same, North Forty (41) one
degree west Forty (30) perches, thence North Ten (10)
degrees East Sixteen (16) perches, thence North Thirty
(30) degrees East Twelve (12) perches, thence North Forty
(40) degrees west Sixty (60) perches, thence North Thirt-
een (18) perches, thence North Eighty (82) two degrees
East Fifty (52) two perches, thence North Twenty (28)
Eight degrees west Forty nine (49) perches, thence
North Sixty (65) five degrees west one hundred and
Twenty (120) perches, thence North Thirty (34) four degrees

west of Hannania and thence (132) two inches, thence
North Twelve (12) degrees East through improved
land of Daniel Stutzman sixty (65) feet
thence to a point on the Public road near
the residence of Daniel Stutzman, whose
distance being two miles and twenty four
feet (2 m 24 ft). Being partly in
Crawfords and partly in Taylor township
We also herewith return release from

At the Court of General Quarter Sessions of the Peace held at Chambersburg in and for the County of Cambria on the eighth Day of August A. D. 1882 before the Honorable Judges of the said Court. The petition of sundry citizens of Casyle township in said County was presented setting forth that they labor in convenience for the want of a public road to lead village of South Fork to connect with public road Summerhill to Mineral Point at or near the residence Daniel Stutzman in the said County and praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view the same.

The Court upon due consideration had of the premises do order and appoint William M. Conant, Daniel Stutzman and William Rose to view the ground proposed for said road, who after first having given due and legal notice by written or printed advertisement of the time and place of meeting and having been duly qualified according to law to discharge the duties of their appointment with fidelity shall proceed to view the same, and if all the said viewers view the same, and a majority of them agree that there is occasion for such road they shall proceed to layout the same as equally to the wishes of the petitioners as may be, having respect to the best ground and the shortest distance, and in such manner as to do the least injury to private property. If the viewers aforesaid shall decide in favor of locating said road it is hereby made their duty to obtain from persons through whose land the same may pass, release from any damages that may accrue to them from opening the same, and in every case when the owners of such land refuse releasing their claim for damages, the said viewers shall assess the damages of any and make report thereof signed by a majority of the viewers present, and transmit the same together with all releases to be filed with the papers relating to said road.
