composing a bench of Quarter Sessions and for the Peace at Sept-
ember Term A.D. 1882 We the undersigned Viewers do Report
that having given ^{due and} timely notice of time and place of the meeting
of the Viewers by three written notices posted in three public places
in Chest Township a Copy of which is herunto attached and after
all being first duly sworn according to law we proceeded
to the duties of our appointment and did view and locate the
following parts of said road in consequence of its never being fu-
lly opened and not used at all by the public Travel and in our
opinion should be vacated being Beginning at County line of Lan-
bia and Blairfield County line near Whitstone Run thence 1st
South forty one degrees East ten perches 2^d South twenty Eight
and one half degrees East sixteen perches 3^d South thirty degrees
East sixteen perches 4th South thirty three degrees East eight perches
5th South ten degrees East twenty perches 6th South fifty six degrees
East twenty perches 7th South sixty three and one half degrees East
Eight perches 8th South forty six degrees East four perches 9th South
Eighty six degrees East fourteen perches 10th South sixty Eight degrees
East eight perches 11th North eighty five degrees East sixteen perches
12^d North sixty four degrees East eight perches 13^d North seventy seven

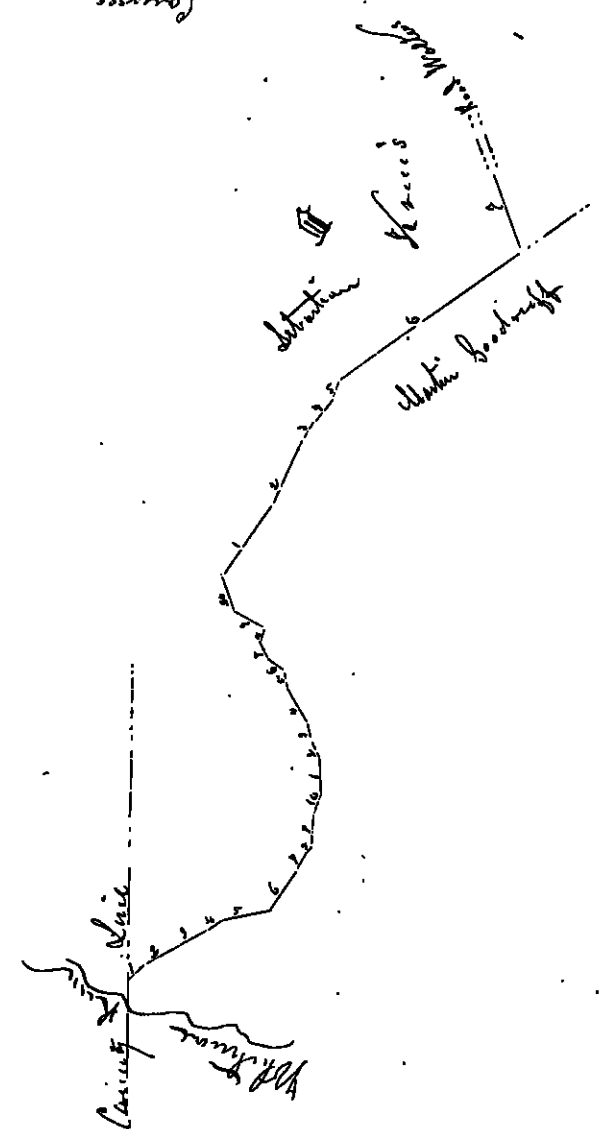

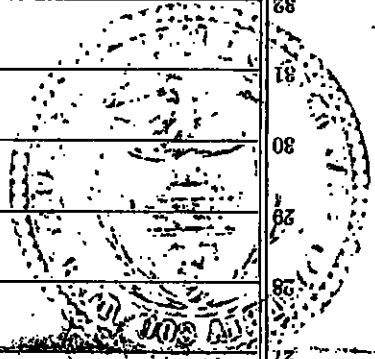

2 At a Court of General Quarter Sessions of the Peace
3 held at Columbus in and for said County on the
4 seventh day of August A. D. 1882 before the Honorable
5 the Judge of the said Court: The petition of the
6 Supervisors and sundry citizens of Chest Township in
7 the County of Cambridge was presented setting forth: That a Public
8 Road has long since been laid out from a point near Martin Hudnuff
9 to a point near Whitman run over the County line between Cambridge &
10 Clearfield Counties part of which said road from a point near res-
11 idence of Sebastian Kinnie to Whitman run over the County line has
12 become useless, inconvenient and burdensome to the inhabitants of
13 said township and praying the said Court that the same might
14 be vacated equally to the Act of Assembly in such cases made and
15 provided. The Court upon due consideration had of the prem-
16 ises do order and appoint Henry Scarslaw, Peter Koubel and John
17 W. Sharbrough to view the said part of the said road proposed to be
18 vacated, who after having first given due and legal notice of the time
19 and place of meeting by printed or written advertisements, and
20 having been duly qualified according to law to discharge the duties
21 of their appointment with fidelity shall proceed to view the same, and
22 if all the said viewers view the same and a majority of them agree that
23 that part of the said road has become useless inconvenient and
24 burdensome to the inhabitants of said township they shall proceed
25 to vacate the same, and make report of their proceedings herein to
26 the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County ac-
27 companying the same with a plot or draft of the part of said
28 road vacated with reference to the improvements through which
29 the same passes, in which report they shall state distinctly
30 that they had been sworn or affirmed
