

Cambria County ss

At a Court of General Quarter Sessions of the Peace held at Ebensburg in and for said County on the 14th day of June A.D. 1882 before the Honorable Judges of said Court. The petition of sundry Citizens of Portage Township in said County was presented representing; That a road or alley has been lately laid out by order of the Court, from the Township road on south side of P. R. R. in the Village of Portage, leading south to Caldwell Street in said Village, which road or alley if confirmed by the Court will be very injurious to said petitioners and burdensome to the inhabitants of the Township through which the same runs, and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to review the same road and parts adjacent with instructions to make report according to law. The Court upon due consideration had of the premises appointed ~~1~~ William Griffith, Philip Critsch and Charles Miller Reviewers, who after having been duly qualified according to law, to discharge the duties of their appointment with fidelity, are to go upon the premises and review said road or alley and parts adjacent, and make report of their proceedings therein according to law; The said Reviewers are to give due and legal notice of the time and place by written or printed advertisements, when they shall meet for that purpose: And further should any changes be made in said road or alley as formerly laid out, it will be the duty of said Reviewers to obtain releases from the owners of lands through which said road or alley may pass for damages, and should any of such owners of lands refuse to give releases for damages, if any, it will be their duty to assess damages, if any, to such owners of lands, and transmit the same with their proceedings herein; Should any change of location of said road or alley be made, the said Reviewers shall furnish a plot or draft thereof, the courses and distance and references to the improvements through which the same passes, and make

The Township Mingle which the same runs and extends on

a full report of all proceedings herein to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County; in which report they shall state distinctly, that they had been sworn or affirmed according to law; and further, whether they judge said road or alley as laid out necessary for Public or Private use.

We the undersigned, persons appointed
to review the road or alley in the within order
mentioned and parts adjacent do respectfully
report that in pursuance of said order, we
did review the same on the twenty ninth day
of August A.D. 1882, having been first duly
qualified according to law to discharge
the duties of our appointment with fidelity
and having given legal notice of the time
and place of meeting, and in our opinion
there is no necessity for said road or alley
for the reason that a public road now runs
nearly parallel with said road or alley as
laid out - being but five rods distant at
one end and eleven rods distant at the other
end

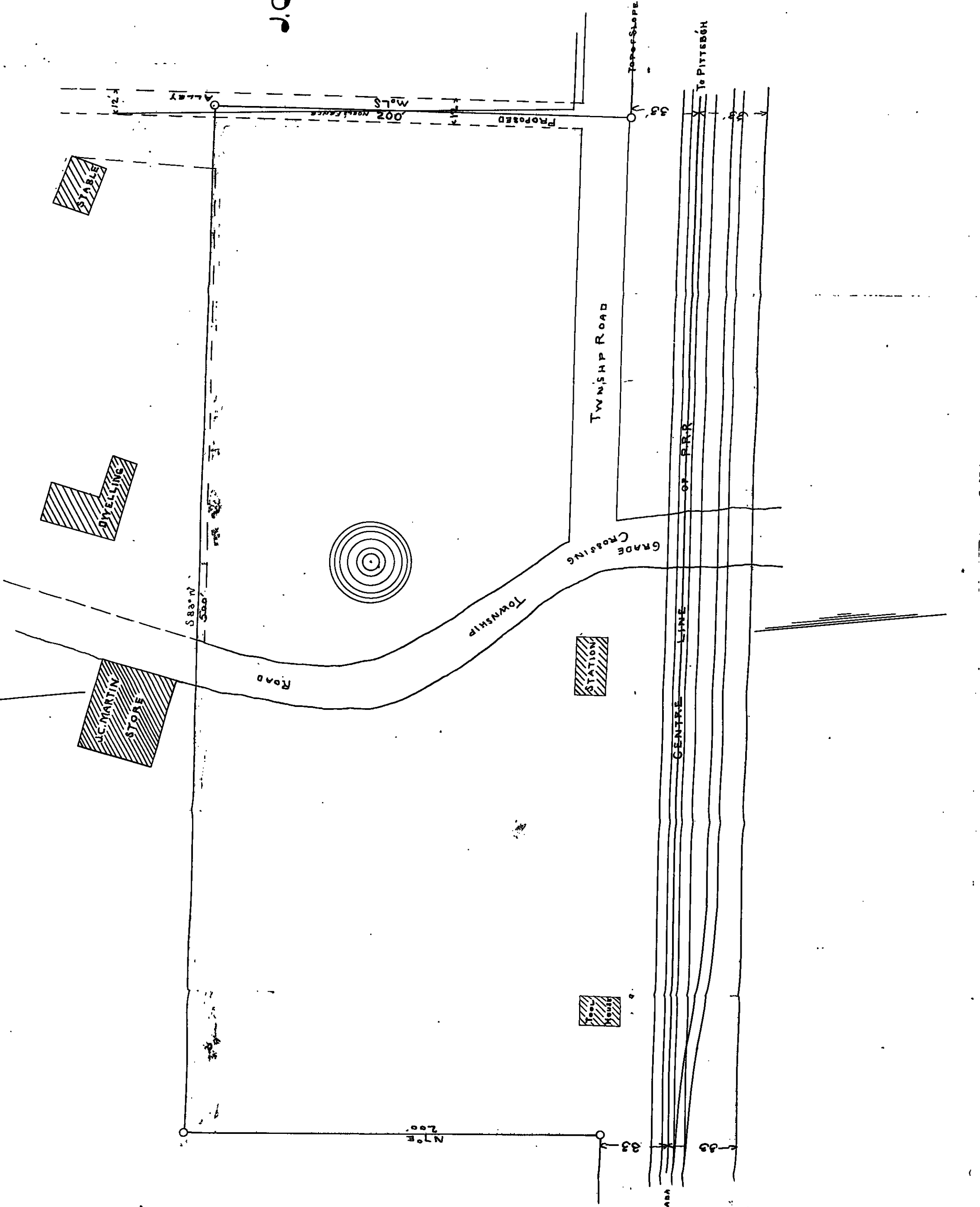
