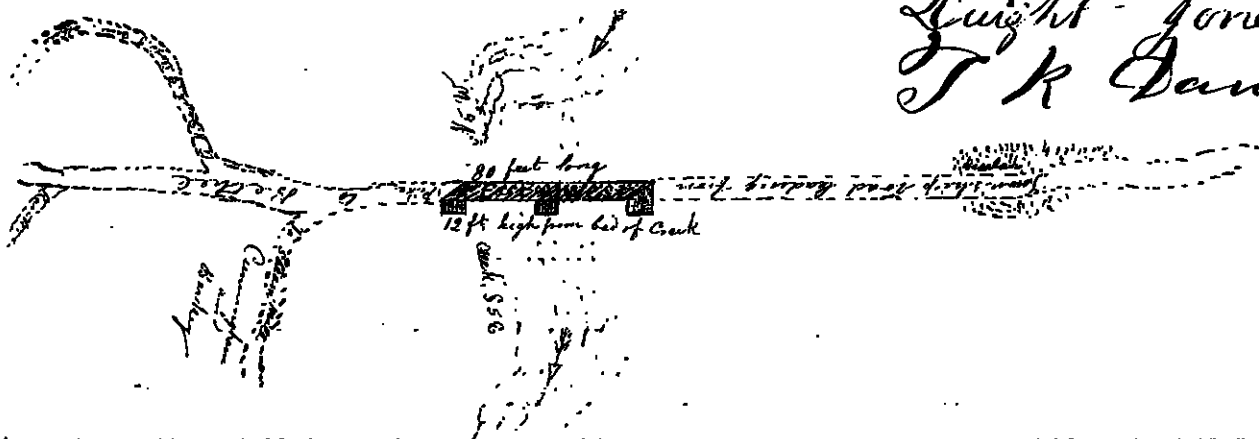


To the Honorable, the judges of the the

 respectfully report that, after giving due and legal
 notice of the time and place of meeting, met at said place
 May 13, 1882, and having all been affirmed, in pursuance
 of said Order, we viewed the premises, and are of the
 opinion that a bridge over the Blacklick Creek in Cambria
 township, near Beulah, where the creek crosses the township
 road leading from Stone pike to Bethel, is necessary and
 that the erection of said bridge will be attended with more expense
 than it is reasonable the said township should bear.

Report of a Bridge
View, near Beulah

Cambria County Ss.

At a Court of General Quarter Sessions of the Peace held at Ebensburg in and for said County on the twenty eighth day of March A. D. 1882 before the Honorable Judges of said Court:

The petition of sundry inhabitants of Cambria Township in said County was presented representing that it is necessary that a bridge should be erected over Blacklick Creek in said township near "Beulah" where the said creek crosses the road from the stone pike to Bethel and that the erecting of said bridge will require more expense than it is reasonable the said township of Cambria should bear, praying the Court to appoint three persons to view the place proposed for said bridge and enquire whether such bridge is necessary and would be too expensive for the said township of Cambria to bear and make report thereof according to law; The said Court upon due consideration had of the premises do order and appoint William S. Lloyd Dwight Jones & T. R. Davis to view said premises, who after having first been duly qualified according to law, to discharge the duties of their appointment with fidelity are to go upon the premises, and inquire whether such bridge is necessary, and whether it would be too expensive for the township of Cambria to bear the costs of its erection, and make report of their proceedings here in to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County; in which report they shall state distinctly that they had been sworn or affirmed according to law
