

Cambria County, Pa.

A Court of Quarter Sessions  
held at Ebensburg in for the County  
of Cambria on the eleventh day of  
July A. D. 1883 before the Honorable  
Judges of the said Court.

The petition of ~~Wm. S. Shuber~~ Shuber of Allegheny  
Township in said County was presented representing  
that he labors under great inconvenience for want  
of the privilege of hanging swinging gates on a private  
road leading from the house of Andrew McCoy in  
Allegheny Township to the township road near the res-  
idence of the petitioner and praying the said Court  
to appoint proper persons to view and judge of the  
propriety of granting him the privilege aforesaid.

The Court upon due consideration had  
of the premises do order and appoint James  
Gallagher, Alexis Parrish and William Burgoon  
to view the premises who after having first given  
due and legal notice of the time and place of meeting  
and having also been duly sworn or affirmed accord-  
ing to Law to perform the duties of their appoint-  
ment with fidelity are to go upon the ground  
and view the same and judge of the propriety of  
granting the prayer of the petitioner and make  
report of their proceedings herein to the next Court of  
Quarter Sessions to be held for the said County. Statute  
particularly how many gates (if any) the petitioner shall  
be privileged to hang on said road accompanying the same  
with a plot or draft of said road showing the points  
where said gates may be placed.
