

To the Honorable the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County:

The petition of Joseph Allen Respectfully represents: That a public road leading from a point on the Frankstown road at Jacob Singers to a point on the Johnstown & Schuylb Levee Turnpike at or near the Old Brewery of Oscar Grafe, was laid out by order of Court at Term 18 and a review ordered of said road at June Term 1882; that he will sustain injury and damage if said road is adopted and confirmed by the Court for the reason that the said proposed as laid out by the Viewers and Reviewers would pass through his lot upon which he has a house in Stoney Creek town-ship, and be a damage to him of about three hundred dollars; that he was not notified by the viewers or review-ers of the time and place of meeting of the said view-ers, nor did he know of the time and place of their meeting or meeting to lay out said road, nor did said viewers ever come to him to get a release for damages, which he might claim for passing through said lot. The petitioner therefore prays the Court to ap- point disinterested viewers to view the premises and as- sess the damage if any there be which the petitioner may sustain or grant a review of said proposed road
