At a Court of General Quarter Sessions of the Peace held at Ebensburg, in and for said County, on the nineteenth day of November A.D. 1883 before the Honorable Judges of the said Court.

The petition of sundry citizens of Carroll Township in said County was presented, representing, "That a road long since been laid out leading from the Ebensburg and Cherry Tree Plank Road at or near the residence of Andrew Stultman in Carroll Township to the Indiana County line, part of which said road has become burdensome and inconvenient on account of steep hills and high drifts of snow on the said road, viz: beginning at or near line of A. Stultman and Mrs. Luther, to said Ebensburg and Cherry Tree Plank Road" and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view vacate and supply the same according to law.

The Court upon due consideration had of the premises did order and appoint Henry Scinlan, Joseph Seaver and Charles Cairn to view the ground proposed to be vacated and supplied, who after first giving due and legal notice of the time and place of meeting by printed or written advertisements, and having been duly qualified according to law, to discharge the duties of their appointment with fidelity, shall proceed to view the same, and if a majority of them agree that there is occasion for said road to be vacated and supplied, they shall proceed to vacate and supply the same as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect to the best ground and the shortest distance and in such manner as to do the least injury to private property. If the viewers aforesaid shall decide in favor of vacating and supplying said road, it is hereby made their duty to obtain from the persons through whose lands the supplied

road may pass, releases from any damages that may
accrue to them from opening the same; and in every case
where the owners of such lands refuse releasing their claims
for damages, the said viewers shall assess the damages, if any,
and make report thereof signed by a majority of the Viewers
present, and transmit the same together with all releases to
be filed with the papers relating to said road. And the said
Viewers shall make report of their proceedings herein to the
next Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace to be held for said
County, accompanying the same with a plan or draft of such
portions of road vacated and supplied, the courses and dis-
tances and reference to the improvements through which said
road may pass. In which report, they shall state what
they had been sworn or affirmed, and also whether they
judge the same for Public or Private Use.

To the Honorable the Judges now composing a Court of Quarter Sessions in and for the County of Cambria

We the undersigned Jurors appointed by said Court do report that we gave legal and due notice of the time and place of meeting of the Jurors by three written notices posted in three public places adjacent to road mentioned in Order of Court. And we do further report that having met at time and place designated in said notice and after all first being sworn according to law to perform the duties of our appointment with fidelity did view and locate the following parts of said mentioned road in consequence of two steep hills and swamp on said road viz Beginning at a point on Ebersburg and Susquehanna plank road near residence of Andrew Stittmutter in Carroll Township thence by said road North Eighty six degrees West forty four perches in said road thence North twenty five and one half degrees West twelve perches thence by same North Sixty five and one half degrees West four perches thence by same North Eighty six degrees West Eighteen perches to point. And supply the same as follows for a Public road or highway Beginning at Pointers on road leading from Andrew Stittmutter to Indiana County thence through improved land of William Luther South five degrees East forty four perches to a point on Ebersburg and Susquehanna Plank road near Barn of William Luther in Carroll Township which in our opinion for the safety of Public travel is necessary to accommodate the public as the parts located are dangerous and troublesome to public

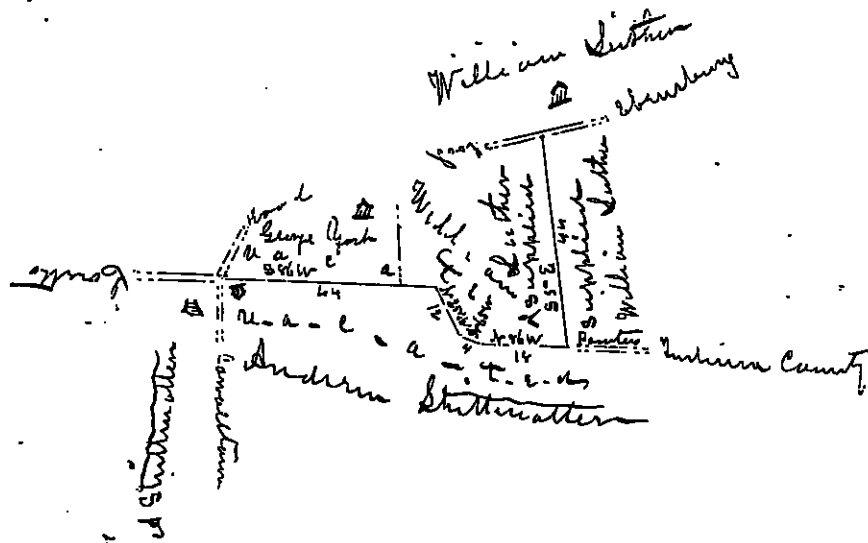
And we do further assess and award a damage of
