

Columbia County N.Y.

At a Court of General Sessions of the Peace held at Elmburg in and for said County, on the thirteenth day of November A. D. 1883 before the Honorable Judges of said Court, The petition of Vincent P. Parker was presented, setting forth, that he labors under great inconveniences for want of a road to lead "from a point at or near McCoy's new bridge on the road from Laette to Crofton, and to end at a point on line of land of petitioner in Washington Township" and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. The Court upon due consideration had of the premises, appointed Henry Scamlaw, John Parker and Thomas L. Parrish to view the ground proposed for said road; who after giving due and legal notice of the time and place of meeting and having been duly qualified according to law, shall proceed to view the same, and if all the said Viewers view the same, and a majority of them agree that there is occasion for said road, they shall proceed to lay out the same as agreeably to the desire of the petitioner as may be, having respect to the best ground and the shortest distance, and in such manner as to do the least injury to private property. If the viewers aforesaid decide in favor of locating said road, it is hereby made their duty to obtain from the persons through whose lands the road may pass, releases from any damages that may accrue to them from opening the same, and in every case, where the owners of such lands refuse releasing their claims for damages, the said Viewers shall appraise the damages, if any, and make report thereof, signed by a majority of the Viewers, and transmit the same, together with all releases to be filed with the papers relating to said road. And the said viewers shall make report of their proceedings herein to the next Court of General Sessions to be held for said

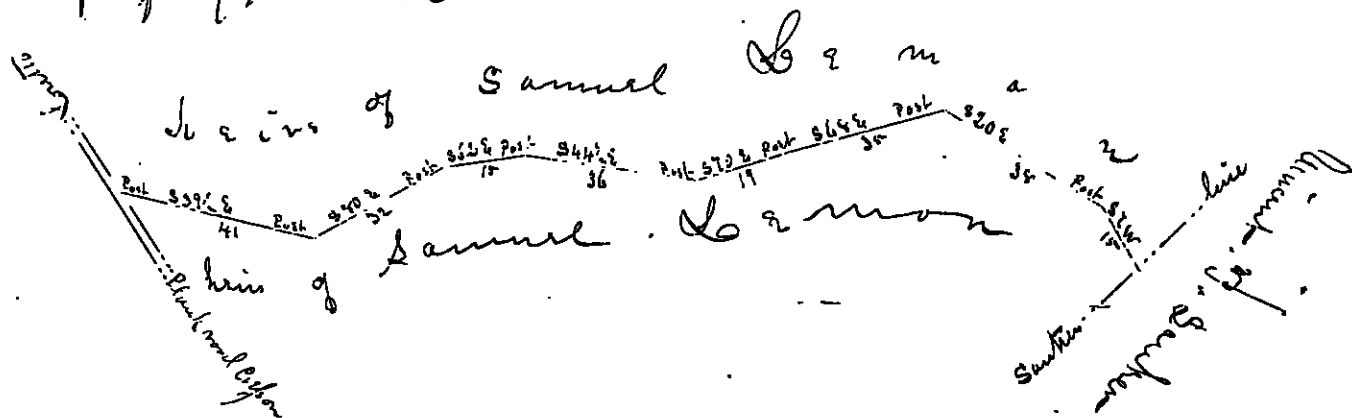
County, accompanying the same with a plan or draft of
 said road, the courses and distances, and references to the
 improvements through which said road may pass, and
 whether they judge the same necessary for Public or Private use;
 and in which report they shall state distinctly, that
 they had been sworn or affirmed according to law.

 degrees East fifteen perches Post thence South forty four degrees East thirty six
 perches Post thence South seventy degrees East fifteen perches Post thence South
 sixty eight degrees East thirty five perches Post thence South twenty de-
 grees East thirty eight perches Post thence South seven degrees West fifteen
 perches Post on line of Benicent Bankers all of said road being in
 Washington Township and in our opinion is necessary for a Private road.

And we do hereby assess and report a damage of five dollars to
 the unimproved land of heirs of Samuel Grinnon all of which
 is respectfully submitted
