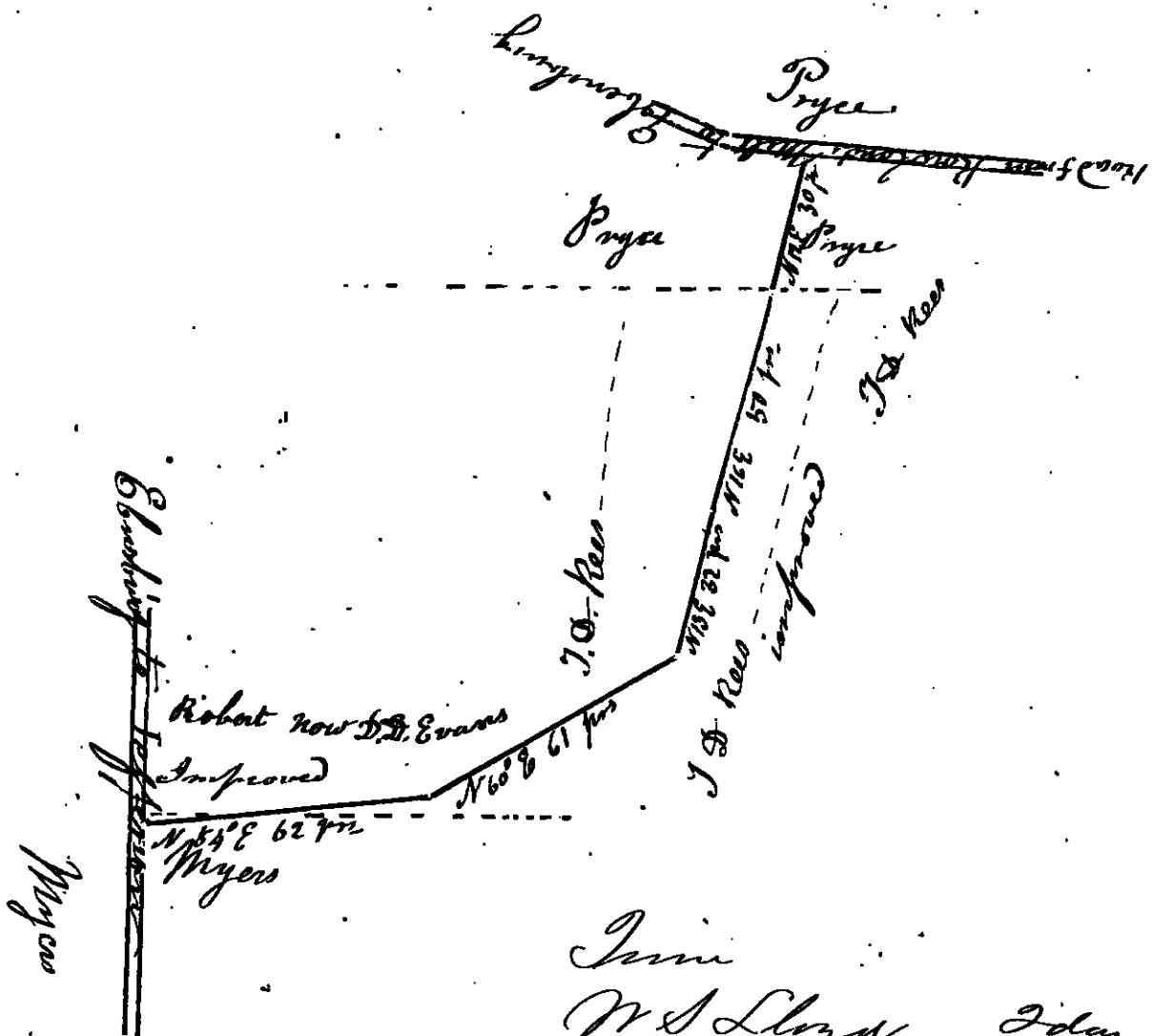
To the Honorable Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace in and for Cambria County; We the undersigned, appointed by annexed order, do respectfully report, that due notice having been given to the owners of land through which, said road was laid out, each and all of us being qualified according to law, proceeded to view the ground on which said road was laid out, finding a portion of the ground wet and swampy and that, it will require three bridges, (one of them not less than 25 to 30 feet long) to make it practicable for public travel. And after giving the matter due consideration, we believe, in our judgement, that said road, if opened will be useless, inconvenient and burthensome to the tax payers of Cambria Township.

And do vacate the following described road.

Beginning on the road leading from Ebensburg to Jefferson
Thence through James Myers' meadow $N 54^{\circ} E$, 62 perches
crossing the ^{line} between Myers' and E Roberts into Roberts' land
Thence $N 60^{\circ} E$ 61 perches through the lands of J. D. Evans
bordering Roberts J. D. Rees, Thence $N 13^{\circ} E$ 32 perches through
J. D. Rees' land Thence $N 16^{\circ} E$ 52 perches through the land
of J. D. Rees Thence $N 12^{\circ} E$ through the land of George Pryce
30 perches to road leading from Edward Rowland's Mill to Ebensburg
near Pryce's house. a draft of said road annexed.

At a Court of Quarter Sessions
of the Peace in and for Cam-
bria County held at Chambersburg
in said County of Cambria
on Wednesday the first day of
October A.D. 1884, before

Honorable Robert L. Johnston, President Judge and
his Associates: Upon the petition of diverse citizens of
Cambria Township representing that on the 7th July
1851 at a Session of this Court, a road beginning at a
point at Myers meadow to intersect a road leading
from Chambersburg to Rowlands mill, at or near David
Pryce's in Cambria Township, laid out by order by
order of this Court was confirmed and that said
road has not yet been opened: that said road if
opened would be inconvenient and burthensome
and praying the Court to vacate it, the Court appointed
Wm. L. Lays, Thomas Griffith and David Tudor to view
the road in the said petition, prayed to be vacated
and to consider and judge whether it is become
useless inconvenient and burthensome and to make
report accordingly to the next Court.

To the Honorable the Judge of the Court
of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County.

The petition of the undersigned,
Respectfully Represent: That on the 7th July
1857 at a session of this Court, a road
beginning, "at a point at Myers meadow, to
intersect a road leading from Ebensburg to
Rowlands mill, at or near David Boyes in
Cambria Township", laid out by order of
this Court was confirmed, and that said
road has not yet been opened.

The petitioners therefore representing
to the Court that there is no occasion
for the opening of the said road; that
if an attempt was made to open said
road, it would be attended with very
great expence, to said Township, the
route of said road being laid through
swamps and gulleys: and if opened would
be useless and inconvenient. And the
petitioners pray that the said order
may be vacated and annulled, and for
that purpose, that the Court, will appoint
three persons, qualified according to law,
to view the ground in which said road
has been ordered to be opened, and make
report of their proceedings to the next

term of this court.
