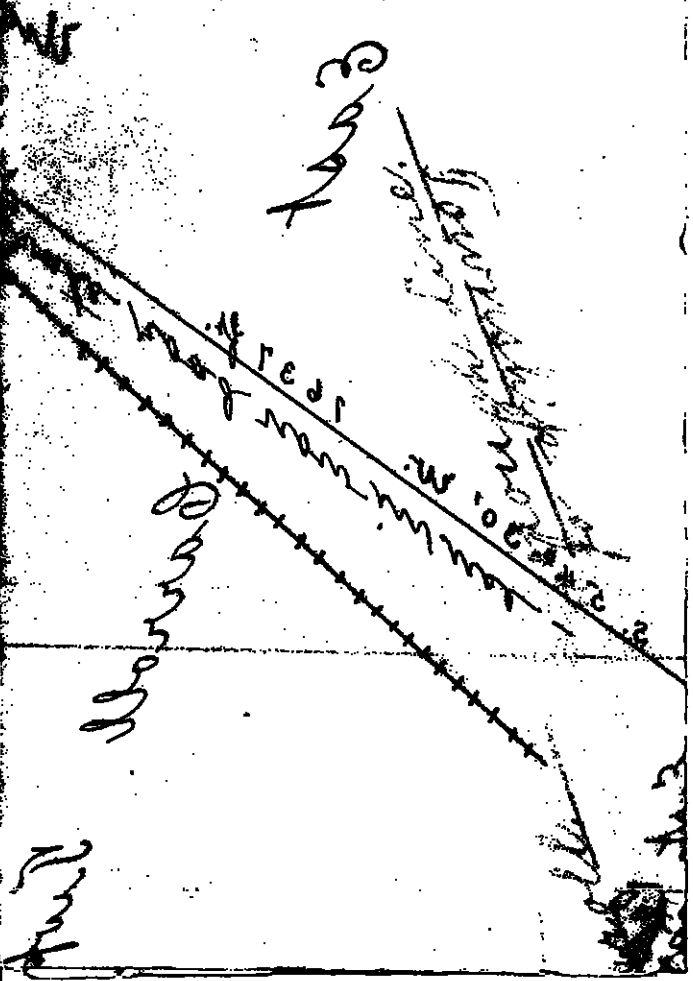

REPORT OF VIEWERS.

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania..

We, the undersigned members of the Board of Viewers of Cambria County, appointed by your Honorable Court upon the attached order, to view and determine as to the necessity of a public road in the township of East Carroll, as prayed for by the petitioners, respectfully report:

That having given due notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers to the Commissioners of Cambria County and to the Supervisors of the Township of East Carroll, by having them accept service of notices hereto attached, and to the traveling public by printed hand bills posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the termini of the proposed piece of road And having been first duly qualified according to law; all of us met at the time and place appointed and having carefully gone over the ground suggested for the location of the proposed new road: a plot of which is hereto attached and made a part of this report:

We are of the opinion that the same is not necessary for a public road . The location of the proposed road, as shown on the attached draft, is as follows: Beginning at a point on Donnelly Street on the Western boundry line of Patton Borough and running thence South $54 \frac{1}{2}$ degrees West sixteen hundred thirty seven feet along a private road, thence crossing Dry Run and through and over unclarred land the following courses and distances; South 32 degrees West three hundred twelve feet, South $9 \frac{1}{2}$ degrees West ninety two feet, South $24 \frac{1}{4}$ degrees East one hundred fifty feet; South $21 \frac{1}{2}$ degrees West eighty five feet to a point on the public road leading from Reilly Avenue, Patton Borough, to Bakers Cross Roads: Said

points of beginning and ending being the same as those designated on the attached order of court. Whereas there is already a public road opened for public use leading from the Patton Borough line within a few hundred feet of the point of beginning of the proposed new road and running for a good distance parallel therewith, and for other reasons the proposed new road is not necessary for the accommodation of the public. A plot showing the location of the proposed new road is hereto attached and made a part of this report.

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."

Know all men by these presents; That Alexander Tuttle
Sumner Simpson Frank Pucala

are held and firmly bound unto the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, for the use of the County of Cambria, State of Pennsylvania, in the sum of ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS, to be paid to the said Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, for the use of the County of Cambria, or its certain attorney or assigns; to which payment well and truly to be made and done, we do bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, administrators, and every of them, firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals and dated the 23rd, day of May, A.D. 1914.

Whereas the above bounden have filed a petition in the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County for the appointment of viewers to view and lay out a public road in the Township of Carroll, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, beginning at Donnelly Street on the Western Boundary line of the Borough of Patton, and ending at a point on public road leading from Reilly Avenue, Patton Borough to Bakers Cross Roads, at a point two hundred feet South of where said public road crosses Patton Branch No. 3 of Cambria and Clearfield Railroad.

Now the condition of this obligation is such, that if the above bounden shall pay all such costs into the hands of the Treasurer of Cambria County, as the court shall direct, then this obligation to be null and void, otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue.
