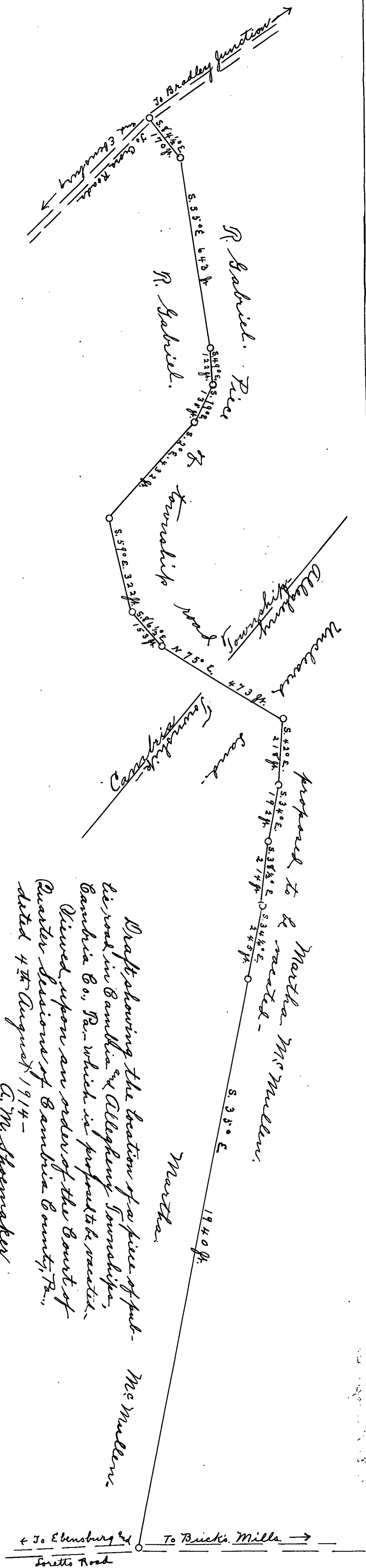

TO THE HONORABLE THE JUDGES OF THE COURT OF QUARTER SESSIONS
OF CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

The petition of the undersigned citizens, taxpayers and residents of the Townships of Cambria and Allegheny, in the County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, respectfully represent:-

That a public road long since laid out through Cambria and Allegheny Townships, beginning at a point in the road leading from Ebensburg to Bradley Junction 3020 feet north from the intersection of the Ebensburg and Bradley Junction road and the road leading from Winterset to the old Carrolltown road and extending in an eastwardly direction through the lands of Gabriel Brothers, in Cambria Township, crossing the Chest Creek and extending through land of Martha McMullen in Allegheny Township, and meeting the road leading from the Loretto road to Bucks Mills at a point 364 feet from the place where the road to Bucks Mills leaves the Loretto road, and 2163 feet from the place where the Ebensburg and Blacklick branch of the Pennsylvania railroad crosses the Ebensburg and Loretto road on the farm of James Scanlan, has become useless, inconvenient and burdensome to the inhabitants of said Townships of Cambria and Allegheny.

That a diligent search of the Road Docket failed to disclose the time or the session the above mentioned road was laid out.

Your petitioner therefore prays the Court that the said road may be vacated, agreeable to the Act of Assembly in such cases made and provided.

R E P O R T O F V I E W E R S .

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

We, the undersigned members of the Board of Viewers of Cambria County, appointed by your honorable Court upon the attached order of Court, for the purposes therein specified, respectfully report:

That, having given due notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers to the Commissioners of Cambria County and to the Supervisors of the townships of Allegheny and Cambria, by having them accept service of notices hereto attached and to the traveling public by printed handbills posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the terminal points of the piece of road to be viewed: Having been first duly qualified according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and to the best of our judgment, All of us met at the time and place stated on the notices so given and having carefully viewed the piece of road referred to in the attached order: We are of opinion that the said piece of road should be vacated. The said piece of road which we are of opinion is no longer necessary for a public road and which has already fallen into disuse as a public highway and of which we hereto attach a plot or draft, which we make a part of this report, takes the following courses and distances, namely:

Beginning in Cambria Township, at a point in the Ebensburg and Bradley Junction road, 3020 feet North of the intersection of the last mentioned road with the public road leading from Winterset to the old Ebensburg and Carrolltown road, and running thence South 84 1/2 East 170 feet, South 55 degrees East 643 feet, South 49 de-

grees East 122 feet, South 19 degrees East 135 feet, South 2 degrees East 432 feet, South 59 degrees East 322 feet, South 86 1/2 degrees East 153 feet, and North 75 degrees East 473 feet; passing into Allegheny township, and continuing thence South 42 degrees East 218 feet, South 34 degrees East 192 feet, South 38 1/2 degrees East 214 feet South 34 1/2 degrees East 245 feet and South 35 degrees East 1940 feet to a point on the Ebensburg and Buck's Mills Road, 364 feet North East of where said Bucks Mills Road leaves the Ebensburg and Loretto Road, in Allegheny Township, Cambria County, Pa. NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."
