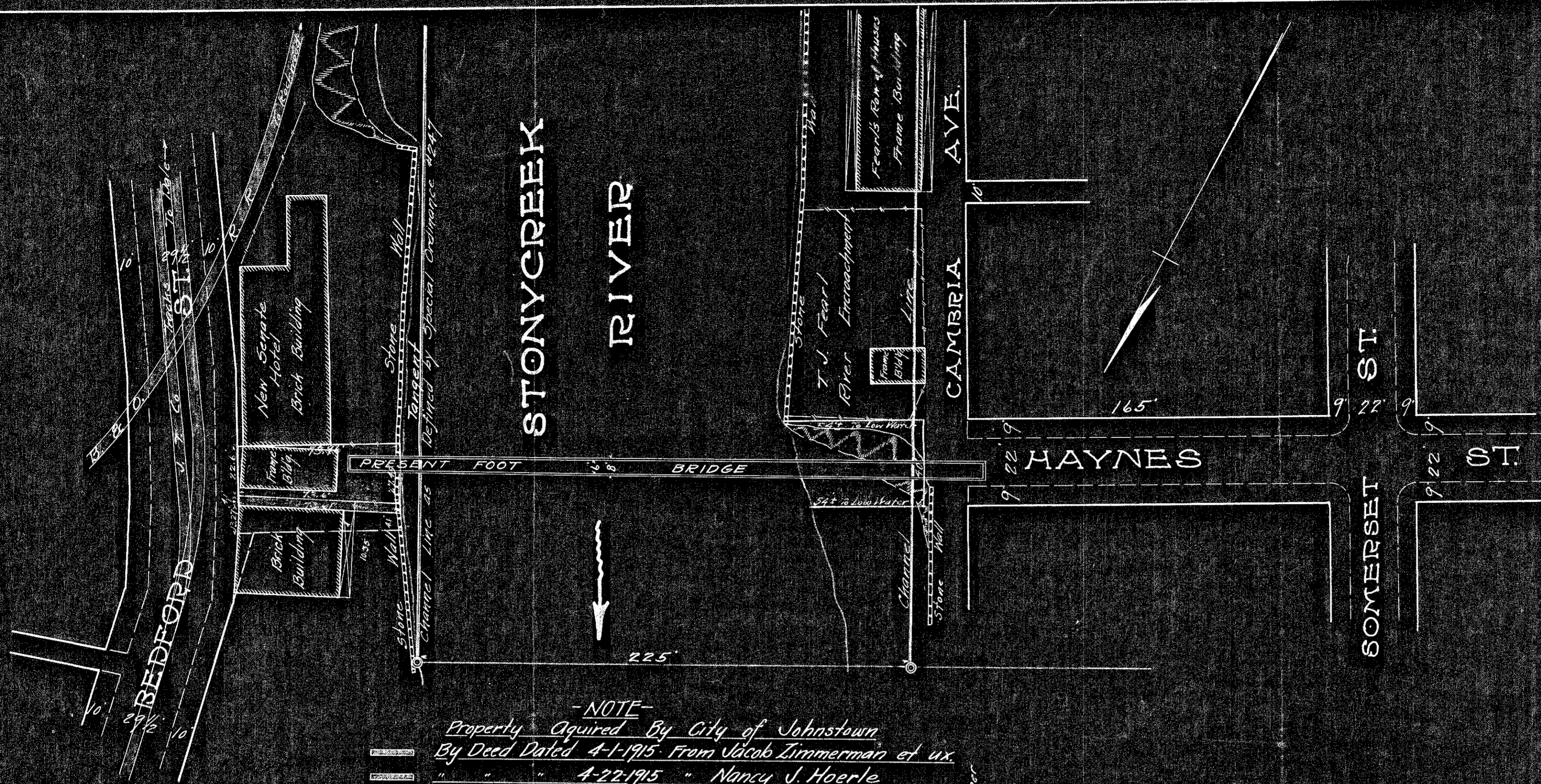


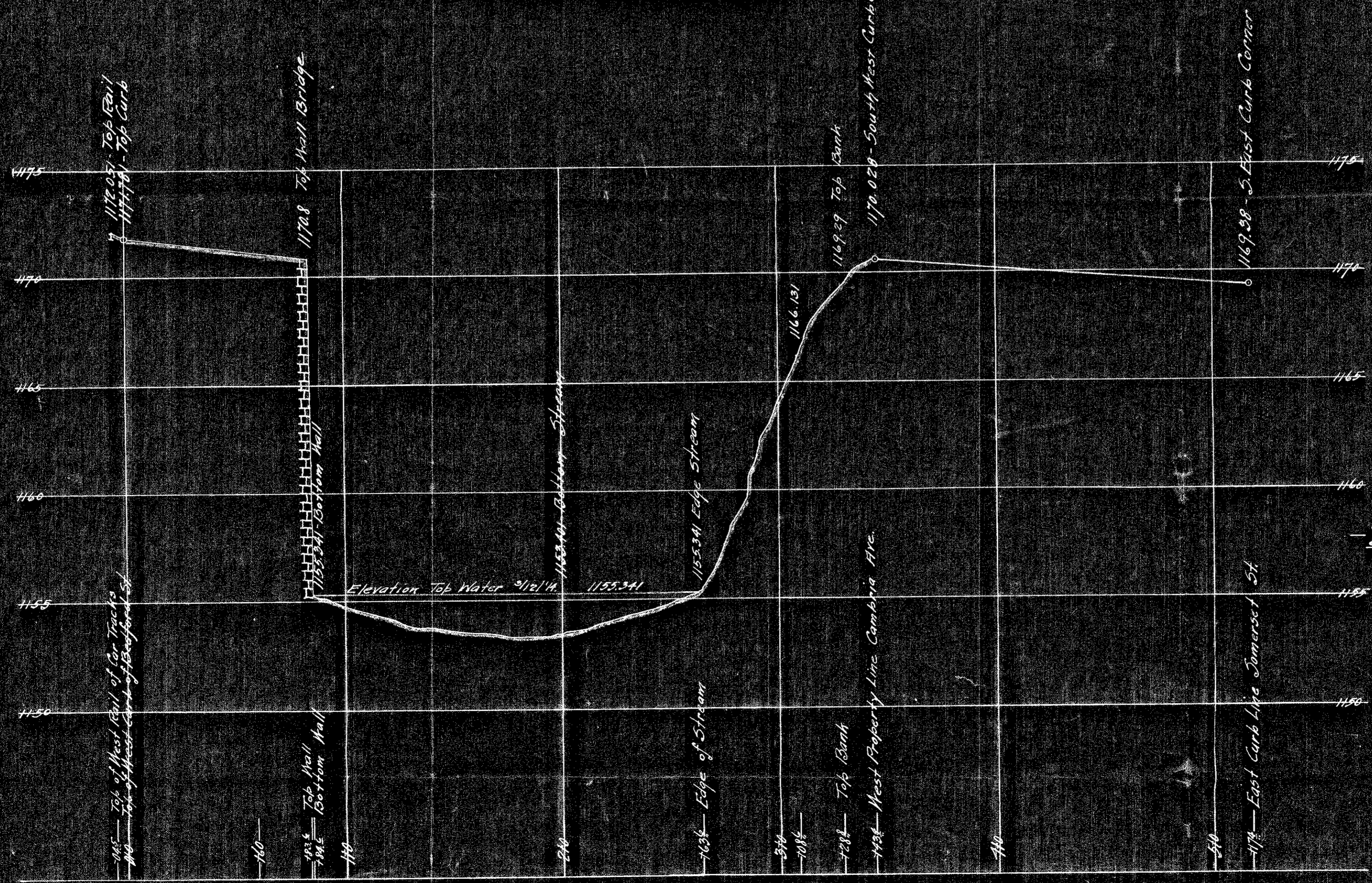

No. 7, September Term, 1916.

In the Matter of Bridge over the Stonycreek River in the City of Johnstown, at a place where Haynes St. in the 5th Ward crosses said Stonycreek River and connects with Bedford St. in 4th Ward, Johnstown, Pennsylvania.

Now, March 9<sup>th</sup>, 1917, the Report of Viewers in the case above stated having been filed, no exceptions made thereto, the Grand Jury, after hearing witnesses, are of the opinion and do find aforesaid bridge necessary, that its erection is more expensive than the city can reasonable bear, said City of Johnstown being a City of the Third class.

We therefore recommend that the Commissioners of Cambria County assist the City of Johnstown in the erection thereof, and suggest that out of the county funds the sum of Twenty Five Thousand (\$25,000<sup>00</sup>), Dollars be expended in assisting in the cost of erection and construction of said bridge.

REPORT OF VIEWERS

To the Honorable, the Judges of the above mentioned  
Court;

We the undersigned Viewers appointed by the annexed order, to view the above mentioned bridge respectfully report, that we have been duly sworn as members of the permanent board of viewers as shown by the records of the court,, that having given due public notice of said view and of the time and place of meetings by posting notices as required by law in the vicinity of the proposed site of the bridge and by service of such notices on the County Commissioners of Cambria County evidence of which is shown by the copies of said notices hereto attached, that we met in accordance with said notices given on the 28th day of October A.D. 1916 at 10 o'clock A. M. and proceeded with the duties of our appointment. That we viewed the ground and site proposed for the said bridge, that a large number of the petitioners and citizens were present and that a representative of the Johnstown City Council was present and heard. After due consideration of all the matter before us we are of the opinion that a necessity exists for a bridge at this site, that the expense of erecting said bridge would be burdensome upon the inhabitants of the City of Johnstown and more than it is reasonable they should bear, therefore, we proceeded to lay out said bridge having due respect to the shortest distance and best ground and in such manner as would be as near as practicable to the desire of the petitioners and at the same time do the least injury to private property, a plot or draft attached hereto *and made a* part of this report shows the location of the present foot bridge which now occupies the site

as laid out for the proposed new bridge the terminies of which come in public highway or property of the City of Johnstown, therefore, we assess no benefits and no damages.

After due consideration of all the matter before us we are of the opinion that the bridge as prayed for by the petitioners is necessary for the traveling public, and that the expense of erecting same <sup>would</sup> be burdensome upon the inhabitants of the City of Johnstown and more than it is reasonable they should bear, therefore, we recommend the proper assistance from the County.
