TO THE HONORABLE THE JUDGES OF THE SAID COURT:

The petition of the undersigned supervisors of the township of Richland, county and state aforesaid, respectfully represent:

That pursuant to the authority vested in them by the act of assembly in such case made and provided, your petitioners propose to change the line of a certain road in Richland Township known as the Walsall Road, the exact location of the proposed change being more particularly shown in the draft attached to and made part of this petition.

That the proposed change of line of the said road is entirely upon the land of one *Joseph* Cooper, situate in the township of Richland aforesaid, and that no other persons whatever are effected or damaged by the proposed change.

That your petitioners have agreed with the said Cooper upon the amount of damages to be paid to him by reason of the proposed change of road, and that said damages amount to twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) and do not exceed the sum of three hundred dollars (\$300.00).

WHEREFORE your petitioners, showing these facts, pray your Honorable Court to approve the proposed change and to order and decree that the new location thus approved shall be taken and deemed to be the public road to all intents and purposes and that the old location shall be taken and deemed to be vacated.

WHEREAS the road supervisors of Richland Township are desirous of changing a section of a certain road in said township known as the Walsall road;

AND WHEREAS the proposed change is located entirely upon the property of one *Joseph* Cooper in said township;

AND WHEREAS the said supervisors and the said Cooper have agreed upon the damages to be paid the said Cooper for the taking of a certain portion of his land for the bed of the new road, the said new road beginning at a point at the intersection of Walsall Road with the road at Krings Station to the State Road and ending at another point on the bed of the said Walsall Road, as more particularly shown on the blueprint map hereto attached and made part of this release:

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that I *Joseph* Cooper, of the township of Richland, county of Cambria and state of Pennsylvania, for and in consideration of the sum of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00), to me in hand paid by the supervisors of Richland Township, at and before the ensealing and delivery hereof, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have remised, released, quit-claimed and forever discharged, and by these presents do remise, release, quit-claim and forever discharge the said supervisors of Richland Township, their successors or assigns, of and from all manner of actions, suits, accounts, claims and demands which I now have or which I or my heirs, executors or administrators, can or may have against the said supervisors of said Richland Township, for or by reason of the opening or maintenance of the said road.
