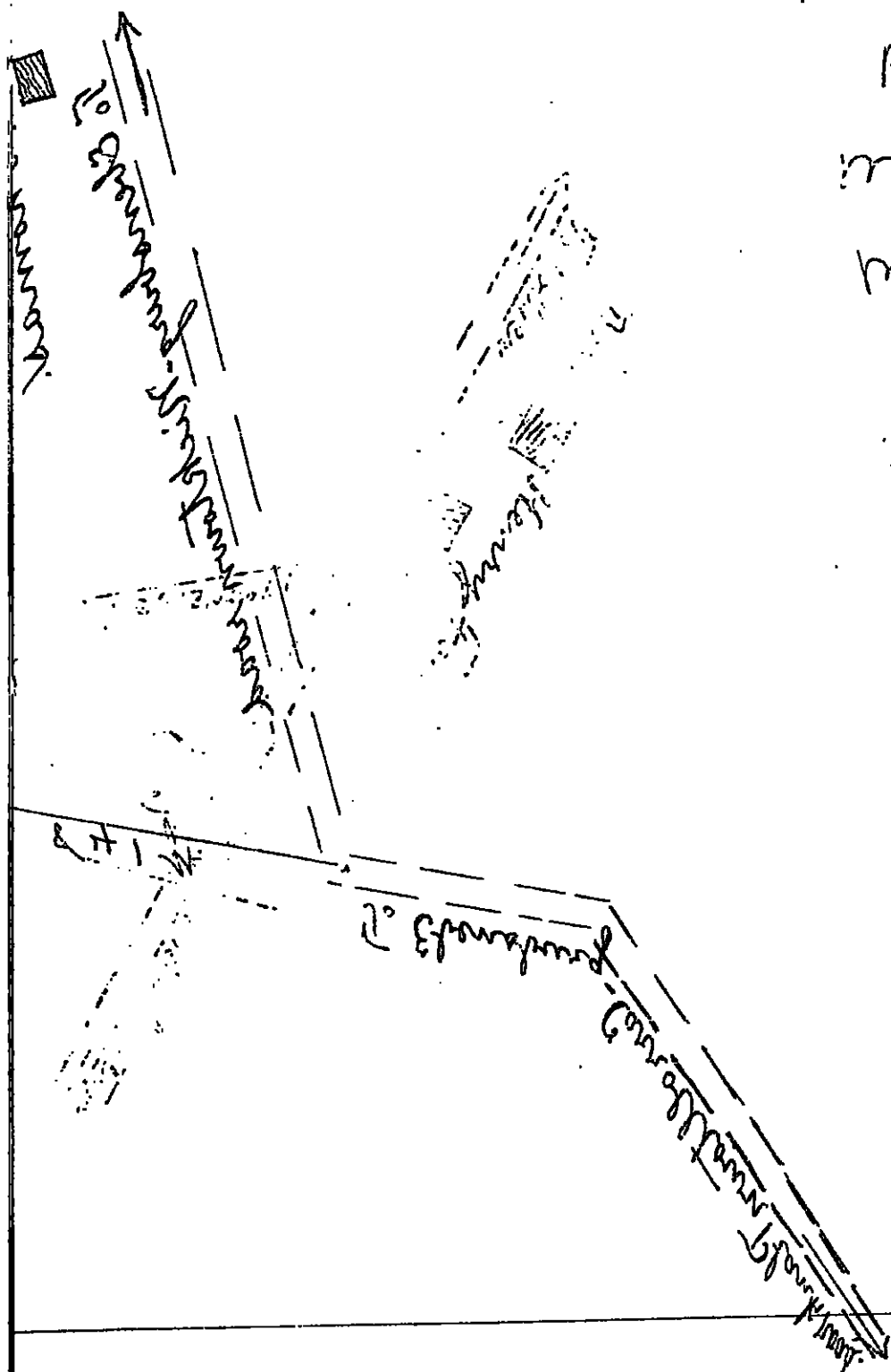



KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, all residents and citizens of West Carroll Township, Barr Township or Cambria Township, Cambria County and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, are held and firmly bound unto the Commonwealth in the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, lawful money of the United States of America, to which payment well and truly to be made and done, we bind ourselves, and each of us, our and each of our heirs, executors and administrators, firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals and dated this 14th day of April, A. D. 1917.

WHEREAS, the petition of certain of the inhabitants and citizens of the Townships of West Carroll, Barr and Cambria, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, has this day been presented to the Court of Quarter Sessions of said County of Cambria, setting forth that a road located in these townships, starting from the Colver and Bakerton road and extending to within a few hundred feet of the Ebensburg and Carrolltown plank road, near the Hermon Church, has become useless, inconvenient and burdensome, and that said road should be vacated.

NOW THE CONDITION OF THIS OBLIGATION IS SUCH, that if the petitioners, after the said view, if called upon by the Court, shall make payment of the costs of said view unto the Treasurer of Cambria County, as provided by law, then this obligation shall be null and void, otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue.

REPORT OF VIEWERS.

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of
Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

We, the undersigned members of the board of viewers of Cambria county, appointed by your honorable court, upon the attached order, for the purpose therein specified; respectfully report:-

That having given due notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers to the Commissioners of Cambria county and to the Supervisors of Barr, West Carroll and Cambria townships, by having them accept service of notices hereto attached, and to the traveling public by printed hand bills posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the terminal points and along the route of the road proposed to be vacated: and having been first duly qualified according to law to perform the duties of our appointment according to the best of our judgment and ability, faithfully and impartially. All of us met at the time and place appointed in accordance with the notices so given and having carefully viewed the premises are all of the opinion that the road in question should be vacated.

A plot or draft of the road proposed to be vacated is hereto attached and made a part of this report and shows also the location of the terminal points and the courses and distances, as follows: Beginning in Barr township on the public road leading from Colver, thru Vetera to Baker-ton at a point 11,271 ft. Northward along said road from its intersection just South of Vetera, with the Ebensburg-Nicktown road and leading thence S. 17° 50' E. 335', S. 48°15' E 378', thru Barr twp., then into West Carroll twp. S. 22°30' E. 348', S. 6° E. 454.5', S. 16° W. 278', and S. 25° 40' W. 618.5', to the line of Cambria twp. then into Cambria twp. S. 45° W. 369', S. 50° W. 258', S. 31°35' W. 480', S. 22°30' W 328', S. 6° W. 255', S. 10°15' E. 274.5', S. 4°30' E. 512', S. 20°15' E. 271.5', S. 28° 15' E. 372', S. 00°10' E. 735', S. 2°45' W. 240', S. 00°30' E. 728', S. 42° E. 521.5', S. 49°05' E. 708.5', S. 34°40' E. 384', S. 34° E. 619', S. viewers, to view the ground proposed for said road, and if they view the same, and shall agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to vacate the same, having respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be as far as practicable, agreeable to the desires of the petitioners, and that they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through which it may pass:

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."

one-fourth ($12\frac{1}{4}$) degrees East seven hundred and fifty-three (753)

which said point of ending is at a point North thirty (30) degrees West three hundred and eight and three-fourth (308-3/4) feet; South forty-five (45) degrees West five hundred and fifty-one and one-fourth (551 1/4) feet; and West one hundred and fifty-seven and one-half (157 1/2) feet from the Ebensburg and Carrolltown plank road, where the public road leading South thirty (30) degrees East joins said plank road, at a point about three hundred and seventy-eight (378) feet northward from the Hermon Church, which Church is situated about mid-way between Ebensburg and Carrolltown, on the aforementioned Ebensburg and Carrolltown plank road; and a search of the record fails to show at what time this road was laid out, but it was a public road at a time beyond the memory of the oldest resident in that community; your petitioners conceive the above mentioned road has now become useless, inconvenient and burdensome. Your petitioners, therefore, pray the Court that the said road may be vacated agreeably to the Act of General Assembly in such cases made and provided.
