

IN THE COURT OF QUARTER SESSIONS OF CAMBRIA COUNTY.

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

Your petitioners being the Township Supervisors of the Township of Reade, Cambria County, respectfully represent that they deem it advisable to change a part of the public road leading from the Village of Fallen Timber to the Village of Glassgow, in said Township, and to vacate that portion of said road from its point of intersection with the public road leading from the Village of Van Ormer to the Borough of Coalport, to a point one thousand three hundred and eighty (1380) feet Eastward from said point of intersection, and to supply the same with a new road, beginning at a point in the said public road leading from the Village of Van Ormer to the Borough of Coalport, two hundred (200) feet North of the point of intersection of the said roads as now located, and running in an Easterly direction one thousand three hundred and seventy (1370) feet to a point in the present road leading from the Village of Fallen Timber to the Village of Glassgow, all of which changes are within the Township of Reade and are shown upon the draft hereto attached.

That agreements have been made with the property owners along said proposed road and the amount of damages has been agreed upon, and that the costs and expenses of the said change or alteration, including damages will not exceed the sum of Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars, and your petitioners pray that your Honorable Court approve the change in said road as prayed for, and will ever pray, etc..
