D. 1919, before the Honorable Judge of the said Court: Upon the petition of divers inhabitants of the Township of Gallitzin, in the said County, setting forth that they labor under inconvenience for want of a Private road or highway, to lead from line of land of William Gallagher and a corner of Valentine Muscavage and Frank Malinowski and to lead from their respective farm-houses or dwellings to a point on the Amsbry-Loretto road by way of Spindley City at a point just immediately East of the school house in Spindley City at the terminus of a lane or private road between the properties of Sanford Nagle and Amil Mileski, said point being one thousand nine hundred and twenty eight feet from the intersection of said Amsbry-Loretto Road with the road leading from Achville to Gallitzin by way of Amsbry, and all situate in the Township of Gallitzin.

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. The Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

viewers, to view the ground proposed for said road, and if they view the same, and shall agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be as far as practicable, agreeable to the desires of the petitioners, and that they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through which it may pass.

R E P O R T O F V I E W E R S .

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of
Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

We, the undersigned viewers appointed by your honorable Court upon the attached order and therein directed to view and determine as to the necessity for a private road between the points of beginning and ending specified in said order, respectfully report:-

That having given due notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers to the Commissioners of Cambria County, the Supervisors of Gallitzin township, the parties interested and the public by having them accept service of notices hereto attached and by printed hand bills posted in public and conspicuous places along the public highway and along the line of the proposed route of the road petitioned for, and having been first duly qualified according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and to the best of our judgment and ability: two of us met (Mr. J. D. Ritter not appearing) at the time and place appointed together with a number of the petitioners and the party through and over whose land the proposed road was laid out and having gone over the route of the proposed road and carefully examined the premises we are of the opinion that the road as petitioned for is necessary for the accomodation of the parties living along the same and therefore have laid out a private road which we consider ~~n~~necessary.

A Plot or draft of the piece of road as laid out is hereto attached and made a part of this report, and shows the courses and distances of same. Having failed to obtain a release of damages from Samuel Mulecki we have estimated the damages sustained by him at eighty dollars.
