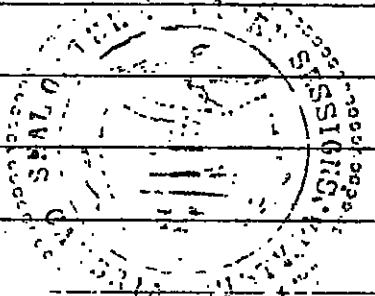


Court of Penna
Cambria County



At a Court of Quarter Sessions
of the Peace of the County of
Cambria held at Chambersburg
in said County on the first
day of March A.D. 1886, be-
fore the Honorable R. D. Johnson, President and
Associates, Judges of the said Court. Upon the pe-
tition of several inhabitants of West Taylor Township
setting forth that a public road sometimes called
the "Mountain Road" leading from a quiet station
old Penna Canal near farm of Griffith to
the Indiana County line was laid out by or-
der of your Honorable Court and that the same
in its present location has become inconvenient
and burdensome and would better accom-
odate the public by being changed so as to begin
near bridge on Laurel Run Road near
Stambaugh and end at same point as above
mentioned Road on Indiana County line. The
petitioners therefore pray the Court to enquire of
and change the said road and to appoint
three persons qualified according to law to view
the said road and ground proposed for said
change and enquire of the premises and make
report of their proceedings at the next Term of
Court. The Court upon due consideration
had of the premises do order and appoint
S. H. Miller, William Galbreath and William
Ripple as viewers to view the ground proposed
to be vacated and supplied and if they agree

that there is occasion for such change they shall after being duly sworn and affirmed to discharge their duties faithfully proceed to lay out the same having respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property and also be as far as practicable agreeable to the desire of the petitioners and make report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary, together with a plat or draft thereof, and the courses and distances and references to the improvements through which it may pass.

We the subscribers the persons appointed by said Court to view vacate and Supply of Road leading from Indiana County Line to the old aqueduct on the Pennsylvania Canal in West Taylor township in the County of Cambria, by being changed so as to begin near the Bridge on Laurel run near Stumbaugh and end at same point as above mentioned Road on Indiana County line.

Report: that public notice having been given by written advertisements of the time and place of when they would meet for the purpose of discharging their duties according to law and that having been first severally sworn or Affirmed in the manner and form prescribed by the said Order. That all of said Viewers to wit: S. W. Miller, William Galbreath and William Ripple, met at the time and place advertised and having viewed the ground proposed for said change and also viewed the part of the old Road to be changed and vacated,

After due consideration had all of us concurring and agreeing that the proposed change, Beginning at near Stumbaugh, would not make as good a Road as the present Road now is, the general grade would be heavier, and be very costly to make and no person benefitted by the change. Therefore we are of opinion that there is no occasion to make the change proposed in said order.
