Carrette to Gallitzin on lands of C. R. H. Hindelwright in Allegheny
Township to a point on the same road near the residence of Gallitzin
Christy in Gallitzin Township.

order and appoint, J. A. Macmaster SURVEYOR,
and H. H. M'Attee & Joseph Hogue

^{change} ~~road~~, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance
and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to
private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the
petitioners, and that they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court
of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county, stating particularly whether they
judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft
thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through
which it may pass.

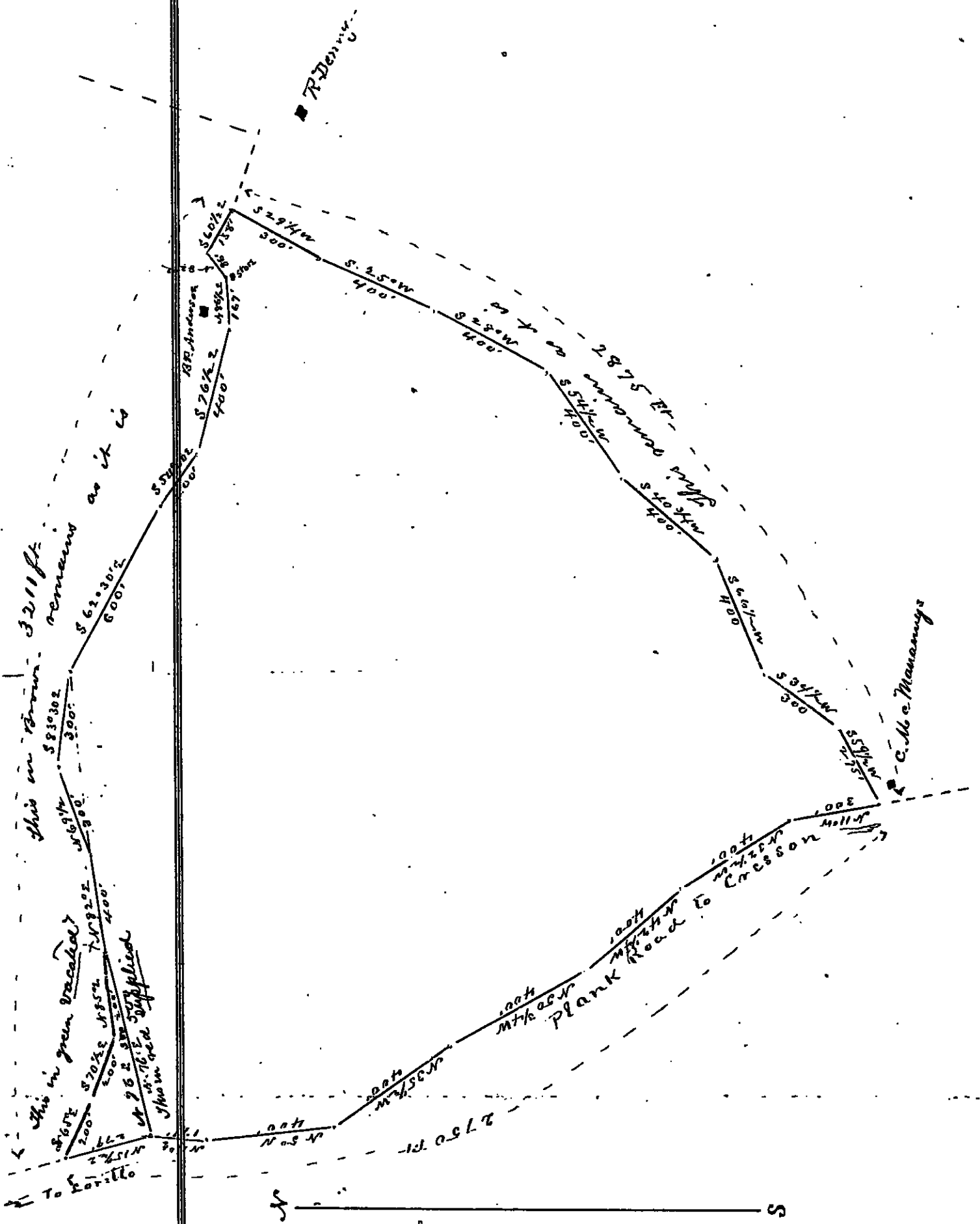

The petition of the undersigned citizens of Allegheny and Gallitzin ^{and vicinity} townships, respectfully represents, that certain roads in said townships have become inconvenient, burdensome and too expensive for the citizens of said townships, as follows.

1. A road leading from the plank road from Loretto to Cresson at a point on land of S. L. Parrish to the saw mill of Albert Owen in Allegheny township.
2. A part of a road from Chas M Mansmeyer in Allegheny township to Mrs Dawsons in Gallitzin township, viz: beginning at a point on line of land between B. P. Anderson and C. R. W. Simmelwright to the end of the road where it meets the Gallitzin road.

Your petitioners further represent that they labor under great inconvenience for want of a public road to lead from a point on the road from Loretto to Gallitzin on land of C. R. W. Simmelwright ^{in Allegheny township} to a point on the same road near the residence of Gallitzin Christy in Gallitzin township.

They therefore pray your Honor to appoint suitable persons, viewers, to view and vacate the parts desired to be vacated as above set forth, and to supply the same by a new road between the points designated.
