

An Ordinance accepting Still alley

as an alley of the Borough of Colerain
Be it ordained and enacted by the
Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of
Colerain and it is hereby ordained and
enacted by the authority of the same:

Section 1: That an alley thirteen
feet wide to be known as Still alley, begin-
ning at a point on the Frankstown road and
extending north 70° east to Singer street,
the center line of said alley being one
hundred and thirty and one half feet distant
from Cassan alley at the westerly side of
Singer street, and said center line being
distant from Cassan alley at easterly side
of Kingston alley, eighty seven and eight
tenths feet, is hereby declared a public alley
of the borough.

Section 2. All ordinances and
parts of ordinances relating to public
alleys of the borough are hereby extend-
ed to said Still alley.
