The petition of C. A. McGonigle, Burgess of the Borough of Lilly in said County, and of the Town Council of said Borough respectfully represents: That the Town Council of said Borough on the 28th of August 1891, passed the following ordinance viz:
Sec. 1. "Be it ordained and enacted by the Burgess and Council in Council assembled and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same that the several proposed streets are located as follows.

1st That street or part of street running from centre of Church Street to North Borough line being an extension of Main St., and to be the width of forty feet (40).

2nd That street or part of street running from a point on said extension of Main St., to a point on Portage St., and to be known as North St., to be the width of forty feet (40).

3rd That a street or part of street running from a point on Main St., to a point at Walnut Alley being an extension of Cleveland St., and to be known as Cleveland St., to be the width of forty feet (40).

4th That a street or part of street running from a point on extension of Cleveland St., to a point at North Borough Line shall be known as Walnut St., and be the width of thirty-five feet (35).
