At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Cambria held at Ebensburg in the said County, on the Eleventh day of March A. D. 1896, before the Honorable Judge of the said Court: Upon the petition of divers inhabitants of the township of Susquehanna in the said County, setting forth that they labor under inconvenience for want of a Public Road road or highway, to lead from a point on the Public road leading to Levin's the Sawmill at the point where said Public road intersects the Cambria and Indiana County line to a point at or near the bridge across Long Run on the Public Road leading from Gannons Mills to Griffis. The said point of beginning being in Susquehanna Township and said terminus being in Beers Township in Cambria County

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to - view and lay out the same according to law. The Court upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint J. L. and Eldin SURVEYOR and Alvin A. Elliott and Samuel Good

VIEWERS, to - view the ground proposed for said road, and if they - view the same, and shall agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property; and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners, and that they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through which it may pass.

and ninety two feet thence south forty
one and one half degrees East one hundred
and fifty five feet thence south forty
six degrees East one hundred and
fifteen feet thence south thirty six
degrees East one hundred and forty
five feet thence south thirty five degrees
East one hundred and fifty two feet
thence south twenty one and one half degrees
