be, of the expense of the same, and did proceed to have such bridge erected, by entering into
a contract with John Ceresa, of Cresson, Pa.,

We, the undersigned, having been appointed by the Court to inspect the bridge recently erected by Cambria County across the North Branch of Little Conemaugh in Munster Township, after having been severly sworn, state that we have attended to the duties of the appointment, and beg to report as follows:

That, having examined the bridge and abutements we find it to be erected according to the contract, plans and specifications, and in a workmanlike manner, and we do hereby approve the same and recommend that the Contractor John Ceresa, be allowed for extra work done to the wing walls on the above bridge 35 cubic yards at \$ 9 per yard or 315- in addition to the contract price for said bridge.
