That a public road beginning at or near Jackson Rager's and
ending at or near the old Pringle mill site, in the Township of
Jackson, was laid out by order of this Court; that a portion of
this road has been vacated and supplied. See Report of Viewers
and order of Court, October 31, 1894, Road Docket Volume 4 page
345; and that the same in its present location has become incon-
venient and would better accommodate the traveling public by being
changed so as to begin and end at the same points, but should be
vacated and supplied in that part of the road beginning at or near
the intersection of Barker Street with First Street, in the Village
of Vintondale, and to end at a point at or near where the said
public road crosses the Railroad siding extending to Vinton Coll-
iery. The petitioners therefore pray the Court to inquire of and
change the said road and in view of such purpose to appoint three
persons, qualified according to law to view the said road and the
ground proposed for said change and inquire of the said premises
and make report of their proceeding, at the next term of Court.
