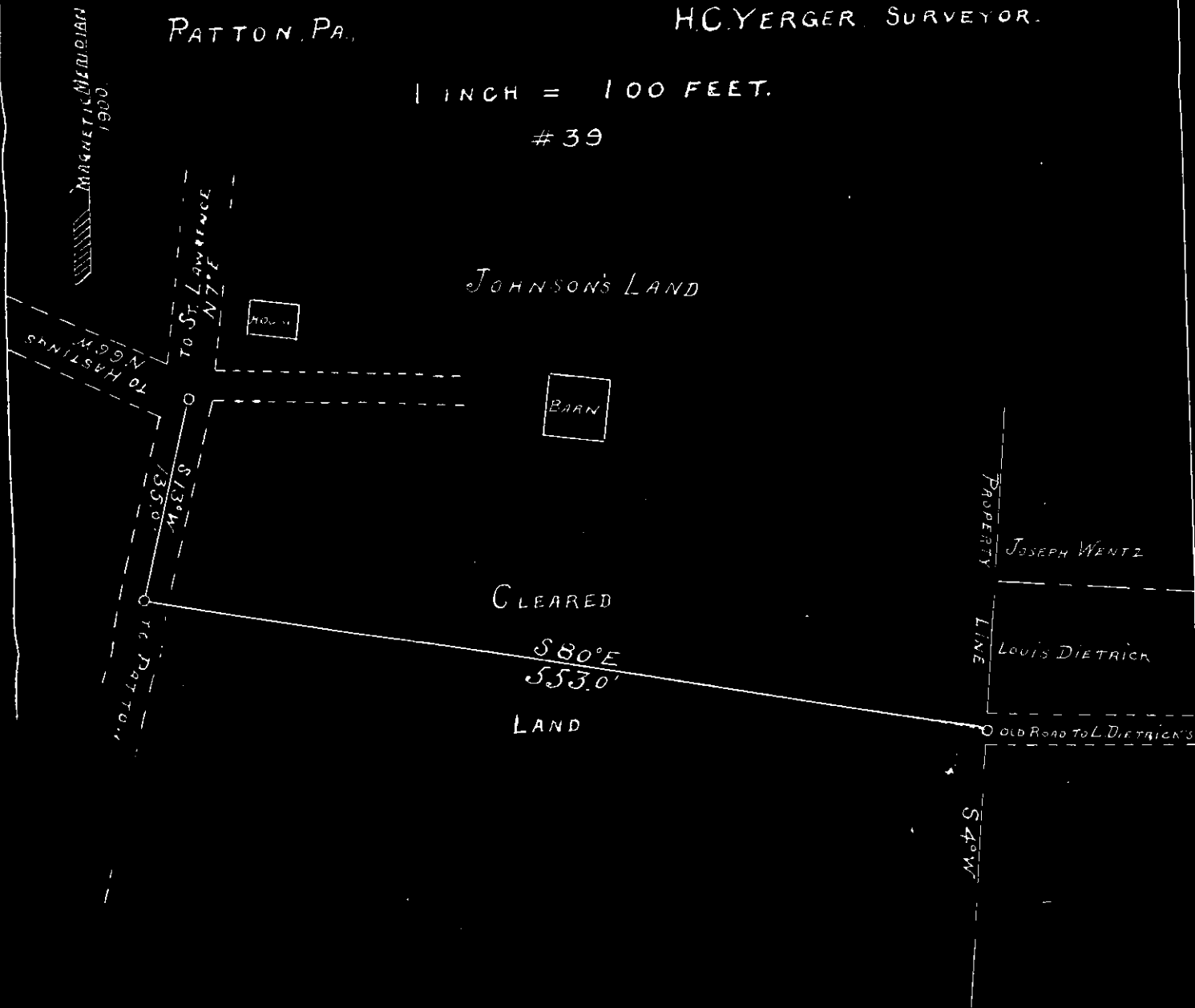

To the Honorable A.V. Barker, Judge of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County.

We, the undersigned persons appointed by the within order of court to view and lay out the road therein mentioned, respectfully report: That after having given due and personal notice to the Commissioners of Cambria County and to Joseph Hipps and Joseph Drass, Supervisors of Chest Township, in which said road contemplating to be built is located, as evidenced by the notice and manner of service thereon mentioned, hereto attached, and after posting at least six notices along the line of the same for a period of ten days prior to said meeting. That H.C. Yerger, Charles Warner and J.R. Cornelius were present on the 23rd day of October, along the line of the same, and having all been first severally sworn in pursuance to said order, we have viewed the ground for the proposed road, and are of the opinion that there is no occasion for a public road between to points named in the order to view, and that the same is not necessary for a public road between the points named. We further report and return, that there is occasion for a private road from the point named as the place of beginning in said order to view and the land of Lewis Deitrick, so that the said Lewis Deitrick may have an outlet from his farm across the land of *John* Johnston to the public road. We have therefore laid out and viewed, and do return for private use of Lewis Deitrick the following described road, to-wit: Beginning at the centre line of the intersection of the Hastings and St. Lawrence roads, thence South along centre line of public road to Patton, thirteen degrees, West one hundred and thirty five feet to post in said road, thence South eighty degrees, East across land of *John* Johnston, five hundred and fifty three feet to line of land of Lewis Deitrick where old private road used to be located.

We further report that the land over which said private road is located belongs to *John* Johnston, that the same land is cleared and under cultivation. That we assess and allow to the said *John* Johnston damages by reason of the opening and construction of said road to the amount of Thirty Five Dollars.

That we have prepared and attached hereto a plot or plan of said road, in which the courses and distances of said road, and the buildings and improvements are clearly set forth. Which said road, so as aforesaid laid out, we are of the opinion is necessary for a private road.

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Cambria held at Ebensburg in the said County, on the third day of Sept A. D. ~~189~~¹⁹⁰⁰, before the Honorable Judge of the said Court: Upon the petition of divers inhabitants of the Township of Chest, in the said County, setting forth that they labor under inconvenience for want of a public road or highway, to lead from a point where the Hastings and Saint Lawrence roads intersect, to connect with the public road leading from St. Augustine to St. Lawrence at a point at or near the North East corner of land of Lewis Detrick in said Township.

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to — view and lay out the same according to law. The Court upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

H. C. Gergei SURVEYOR, and Chas Warner and J. R. Cornelius

VIEWERS, to — view the ground proposed for said road, and if they — view the same, and shall agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desires of the petitioners, and that they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through which it may pass.

NOTE.—"It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report, at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: first, who of them were present at the view; second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams,) where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."
