To the Honorable A. V. Barker President Judge of
Quarter Sessions of Cambria County Pa. We the
undersigned viewers, appointed by the aforesaid
Order do report. That in pursuance thereof,
after having been severally duly sworn or
affirmed to perform our duties impartially
and to the best of our judgment, and having
served copies of said notices upon the Supervisors
of the territory through which such road is vacated
and supplied and laid out and also upon the
County Commissioners of said County, properly attested
copies of said notices being hereto attached, The
viewers appointed by said order viewed the ground
proposed for the within mentioned road to be
vacated & supplied and the undersigned
do agree and believe that a portion of a public
road known as the Hopper Valley road in Carroll
Township to wit: that portion of said road leading
from a point where Deacons Street on the plan of
Bakerton intersects said road on the line between
lots Nos 5 and 6 on said plan to a point about one
hundred feet South Easterly from the place where the other
end of said Deacons Street intersects said road on
land of Leonard Farabaugh has become inconvenient
and burdensome to the inhabitants of said township
and ought therefore to be vacated and have
viewed and vacated the same as follows. Beginning
at a point where Deacons Street on the plan of Bakerton
intersects said road on line between lots Nos 5 and 6
on said plan thence south fifty six degrees
East three hundred and fifty feet thence South

sixty six and one half degrees East three hundred
 and ninety two feet thence South twenty nine and
 one half degrees East three hundred and forty
 eight feet thence South forty one degrees East
 three hundred and eighteen feet thence North
 fifty six and three fourth degrees East one
 hundred and twenty two feet thence South
 twenty eight degrees East one hundred and
 twenty five feet thence South ten and three
 fourth degrees East two hundred feet
 thence South twenty eight and three fourth degrees
 West one hundred and thirty four feet to a point
 about one hundred feet South easterly from the
 place where the other end of said Deacons street
 intersects said road on land of Leonard Farabaugh

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Cambria held at Ebensburg in the said County, on the fourteenth day of January A. D: ~~189~~¹⁹⁰¹, before the Honorable Judge of the said Court: Upon the petition of divers inhabitants of the Township of Carroll in the said County, setting forth that they labor under inconvenience for want of a ~~having a public~~ ^{and for want of a public road or highway} road or highway, to lead from

That a portion of a public highway known as the "Stopper Valley" road in said Township, to-wit: that portion of said road leading from a point where D. Weaver Street on the plan of Sakerston intersects said road on line between lots Nos. 5 and 6 on said plan, to a point about one hundred feet Southeastely from the place where the other end of said Weaver Street intersects said road on land of Howard Garabough, has become useless, inconvenient and burdensome to the inhabitants of said township by reason of the fact that its place has been supplied by said Weaver Street which is traveled in preference that part of said road above described, and is in better condition for travel and more easily kept up in fit condition

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to ^{vacate} view and lay out the same according to law. The Court upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

J. David Elder SURVEYOR, and Peter Campbell and H. J. Vandusen

VIEWERS, to view the ground proposed for said road, and if they view the same, and shall agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desires of the petitioners, and that they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through which it may pass.

NOTE.—"It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report, at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: first, who of them were present at the view; second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams,) where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."
