At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Cambria held at Ebensburg in the said County, on the Second day of March A. D. 1908, before the Honorable Judge of the said Court: Upon the petition of divers inhabitants of the Township of Cambria, Blacklick and Jackson and the Borough of Ebensburg of _____, in the said County, setting forth that they labor under inconvenience for want of a public road or highway, to lead from a point where the Huntingdon, Ebensburg and Pittsburg pike crosses the Ebensburg and Blacklick Branch of the Pennsylvania Railroad, at or near the Borough of Ebensburg, to a point at the Eastern end of Barker Street in the Village of Vintondale, Jackson Township

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. The Court upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

J. J. Elder SURVEYOR, and

John J. Evans and J. L. Edwards.

VIEWERS, to view the ground proposed for said road, and if they view the same, and shall agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desires of the petitioners, and that they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through which it may pass.

The petition of the undersigned inhabitants of Ebensburg Borough
and the Townships of Cambria, Blacklick, and Jackson, in Cambria County
Pennsylvania, respectfully represents:

That they labor under great inconvenience for want of a public
road or highway beginning at a point where the ~~Ebensburg~~, Huntingdon
and Ebensburg ^{and Pittsburgh} pike crosses the Ebensburg and Blacklick Branch of the
Pennsylvania Railroad, at or near the Borough of Ebensburg, to a point
at the Eastern end of Barker Street in the Village of Vintondale,
Jackson Township.

The petitioners therefore pray the Court to appoint three
discreet, and disinterested persons qualified according to law to
view a site for a road between the points above designated, and to
secure releases from the property owners along and over which said
