Report of viewers in re proposed public road in Jackson, West Taylor and East Taylor Townships. No. 4 Sept. Sessions, 1905.

To the Honorable F. J. O'Connor, President Judge of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County.

We, the undersigned, appointed by the annexed order do report; that in pursuance thereof after having been severally duly sworn or affirmed, did view the ground proposed for the within mentioned road and do agree that there is occasion and necessity for a public road as desired by petitioner; and having had respect to the shortest distances and best ground for such a road, we have laid it out to do the least injury to private property and so far as practicable agreeably to the desires of petitioners and do return for public use a public road by the following courses and distances: Beginning at a post, corner of public road leading to Johnstown, North $62 \frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ East 297 feet from house owned by Zachariah Varner and now occupied by Aaron Croyle; thence South 70° East 287.2 feet ~~along~~^{thru} land of John S. Hunt to a post; thence ~~thru~~ same South $69^{\circ} 30'$ East 194.7 feet to a post; thence by the same South $56^{\circ} 15'$ East 109.9 feet to a post; thence by same South $15^{\circ} 45'$ East 249.7 feet to a post; thence by same South $45^{\circ} 30'$ East 196 feet to a post; thence South $22^{\circ} 15'$ East 140 feet to post; thence South 60° East 770 feet to a post; the foregoing courses and distances following lane now in use; and land of John Wissinger thence ~~thru~~ land of John S. 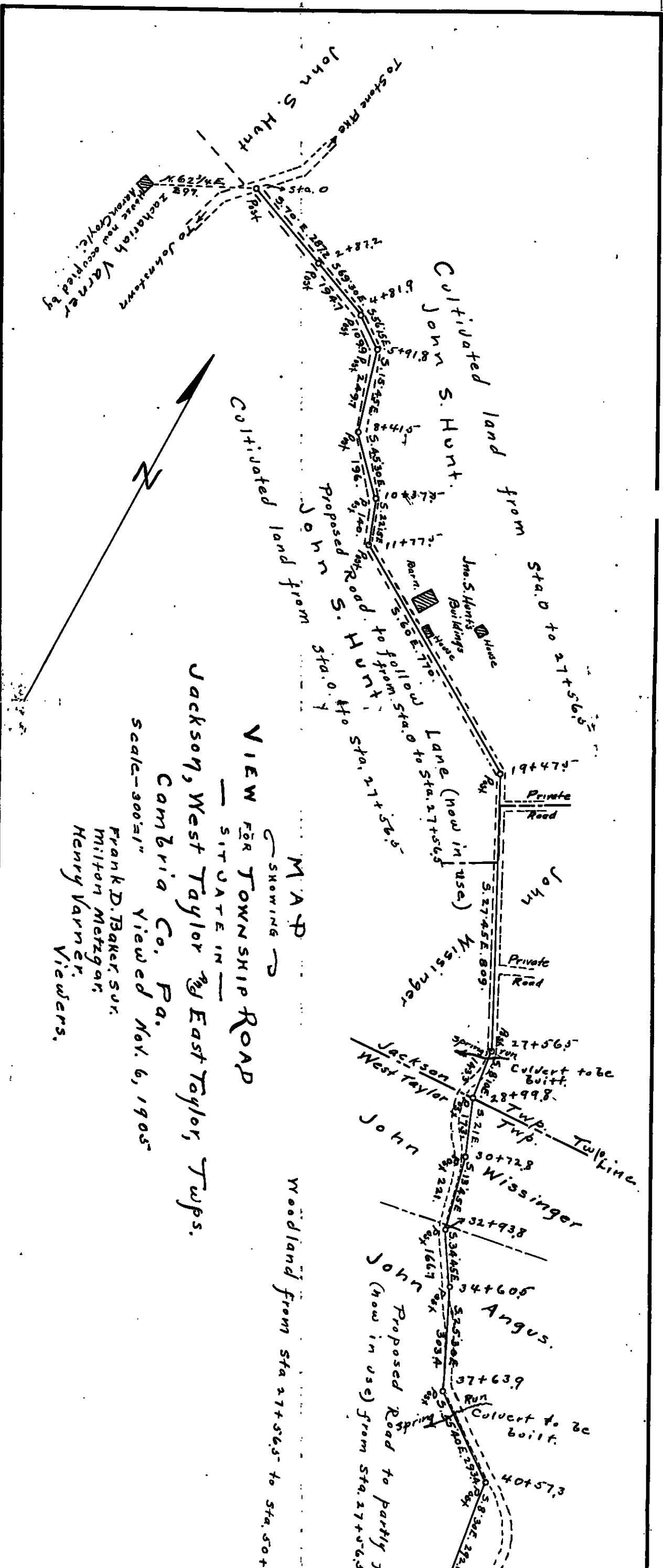

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages, and it shall appear to them that any majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as assessors shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."

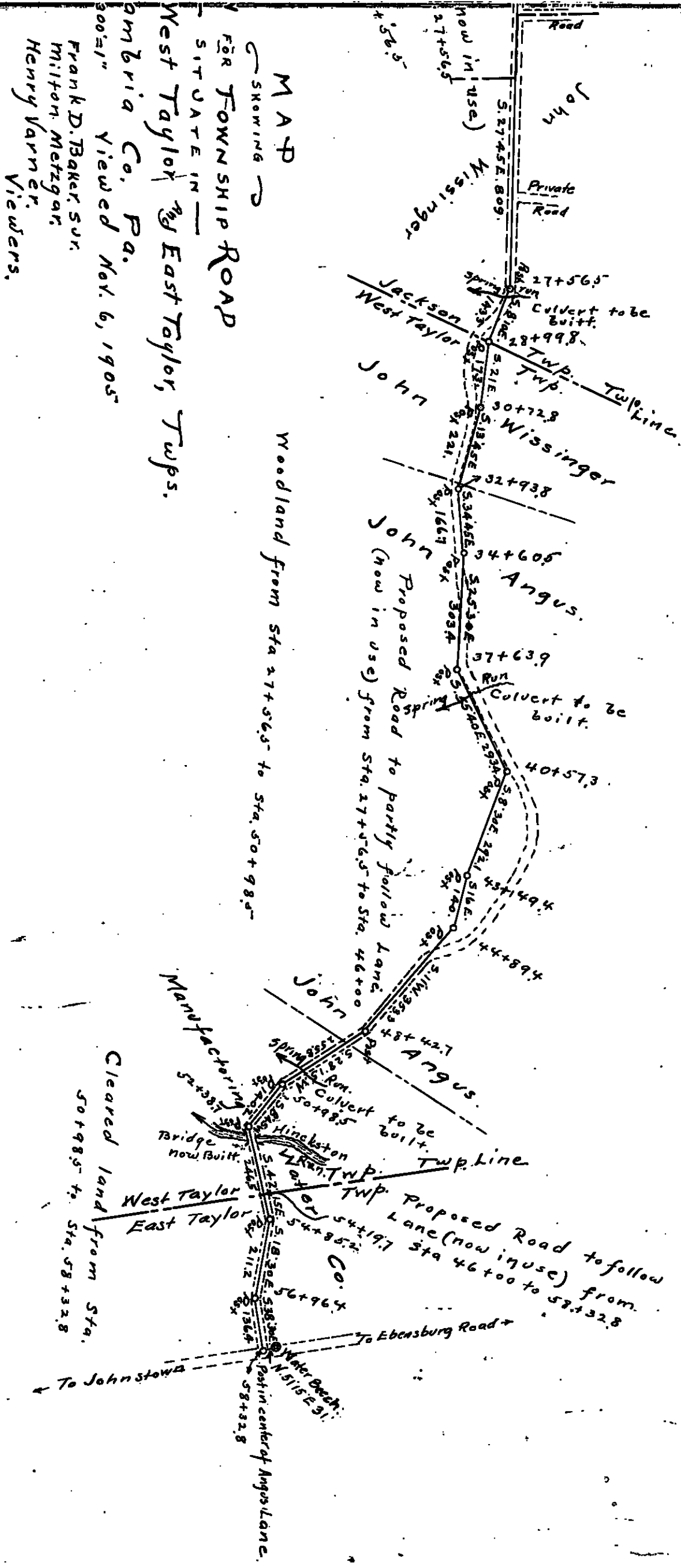


MAP
