To the Honorable Francis J. O'Connor, President Judge of the above named Court.

The petition of the undersigned, citizens of Croyle and Sum-merhill Townships, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, respectfully represents: That they labor under great inconvenience for want of a public road to begin at a point on a public road at the foot of the hill east of the three arch stone Pennsylvania Railroad bridge, at the west end of the deep cut in Croyle Township, and ending on the public road near the Stone arch bridge over the Old Portage Railroad near the east end of the present deep cut in said Croyle Township. The petitioners therefore pray the Court to appoint three qualified persons to view the ground proposed for such road, and, if they see occasion to lay out same, to inquire of and vacate the public road now opened from the aforesaid points on the line of the proposed road in said Township, which said last mentioned road will, by reason of the laying out of the proposed road, become useless; and make report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions.
