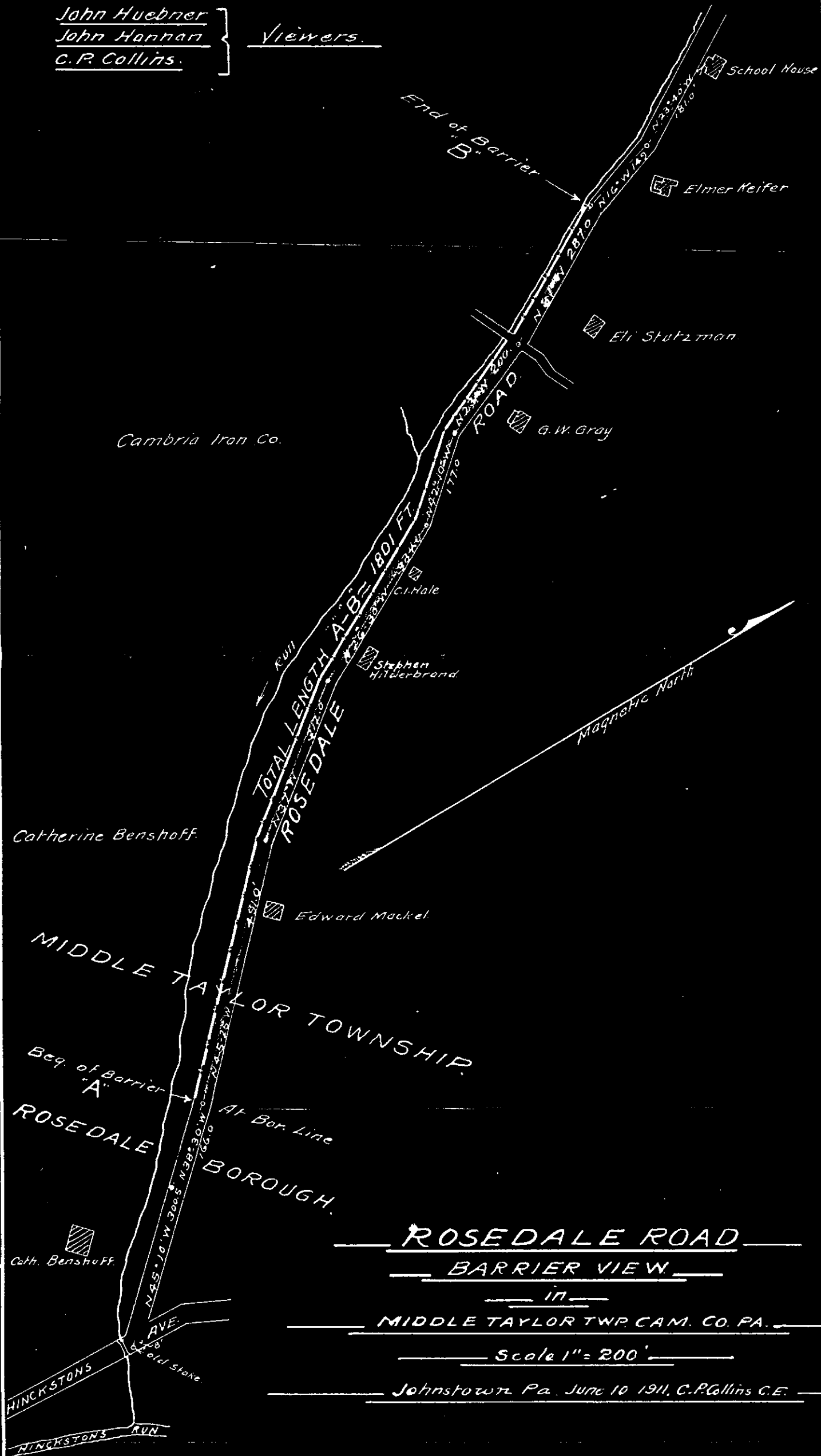

In the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Penna.

To the Honorable F. J. O'Connor, President Judge of said Court:

The petition of the undersigned inhabitants of Middle Taylor Township, Cambria County, respectfully represent; That there is need for a barrier upon a public highway between points hereinafter mentioned, and that the expense of erecting the same is more than the Township can reasonably bear; the said portions of the aforesaid highway needing barriers being entirely within the said Township of Middle Taylor and described thus: For a portion of a public highway known as *Rosedale Road* leading from Rosedale at its intersection with *Hinckston Ave.* Street, formerly the Hinckston Run Road; and thence following said highway to its intersection with the Ben-shoff Hill Road, also a public highway, at the Pleasant View Church; a distance of four-tenths of a mile.

Wherefore your petitioners pray the Court to order a view in the manner provided for in the case of roads to view the premises for the purpose of determining whether or not such guards or barriers are necessary and whether or not the same would be too expensive for said Township to erect and maintain; and report to make thereon as provided by the Act of Assembly of May 25, 1878, P. L. 150 and its supplements.
