

TO THE HONORABLE FRANCIS J. O'CONNOR, PRESIDENT JUDGE OF THE COURT
OF QUARTER SESSIONS OF CAMBRIA COUNTY, IN THE STATE OF PENNSYLVANIA.

The petition of the undersigned inhabitants of the Township of Carroll, in said County and State respectfully represents: That a part of a road long since laid out through said Township of Carroll, to wit, what is known as the Old State Road where it passes Northward from the Borough of Carrolltown, and extending through said Township of Carroll and through the Township of Susquehanna to Cherrytree, in the County of Indiana, known locally as the "Ridge" road, has become inconvenient and burdensome to the inhabitants of the said Township by reason of the steep grades on said road, the difficulty of keeping said road in repair and the heavy drifting by snow in the winter time: the part thus affected and which has become inconvenient and burdensome, and which it is desired to have vacated, extending from what is known as Baker's Cross Roads North of Carrolltown, to a point on land of Isaac Weakland about two hundred feet from line of Michael Galuscheck. At Baker's Cross Roads said "Ridge" road intersects with a public road leading in the direction of St. Boniface, and another public road leading in the direction of Patten. The nearest road to the point 200 feet from land of Michael Galuscheck is a distance of about thirty-one hundred and ninety feet on said "Ridge" road Northward from the point of intersection at said Cross Roads.

That there is no record of the said State road in the office of the Clerk of the Court of Quarter Sessions of said County, and hence your petitioners are unable to comply with the Rule of Court requiring a reference to the number and term of the original case or to the number and page of the Docket containing the record thereof.

They therefore pray your Honor to appoint three persons properly qualified to view the premises and report to the Court upon the expediency of vacating the same. And they will, etc.

ROAD NOTICE.

TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

The undersigned viewers appointed by the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania, to inquire into and report upon the expediency of vacating a part of a public road known as the old State or Ridge Road, in the Township of Carroll, in said County and State, to wit, a part of said road extending from what is known as Baker's Cross Roads North of Carrolltown, to a point on land of Isaac Weakland about 200 feet from land of Michael Galuscheck, give notice hereby that they will meet at said Cross Roads on Thursday the 1st day of September 1910 at 9 o'clock A.M. to attend to the duties of their said appointment; at which time and place all persons interested may attend if they see proper.

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."
