We, the undersigned, Members of the Board of Viewers of Cambria County, appointed by your Honorable Court to view a certain piece of road in Adams Township, Cambria County, Pa., for the purpose of determining as to the propriety of vacating the same, which said piece of road is more fully described in the Order of Court hereto attached, respectfully report:-

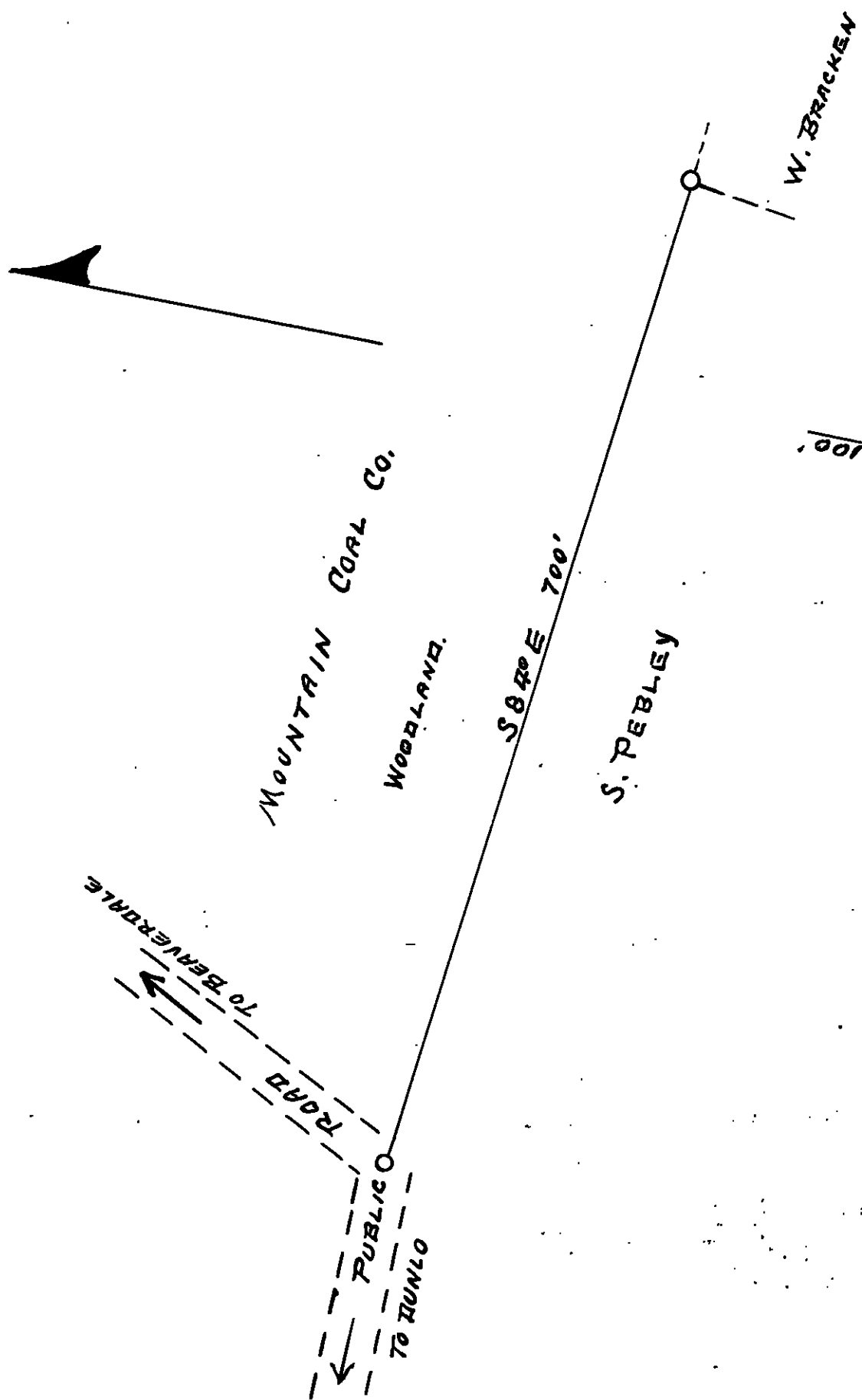
That in pursuance of said order, after having given due public notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the Viewers, to the County Commissioners of Cambria County and the Supervisors of Adams Township by having them accept service of notices and to the traveling public by printed handbills posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the termini of the said road; All of us met in accordance therewith and having been first duly qualified according to law to faithfully, impartially and to the best of our ability perform the duties of our appointment we viewed the premises and are of opinion that the said road; a draft or plot of which is hereto attached and made a part of this report; is no longer necessary for a public road.

The said road above referred to, begins at a point in the public road which leads from Dunlo to Beaverdale and runs thence South 84 degrees E. 700 feet between lands of the Mountain Coal Company and S. Pebley to property of W. Bracken, which said piece of road

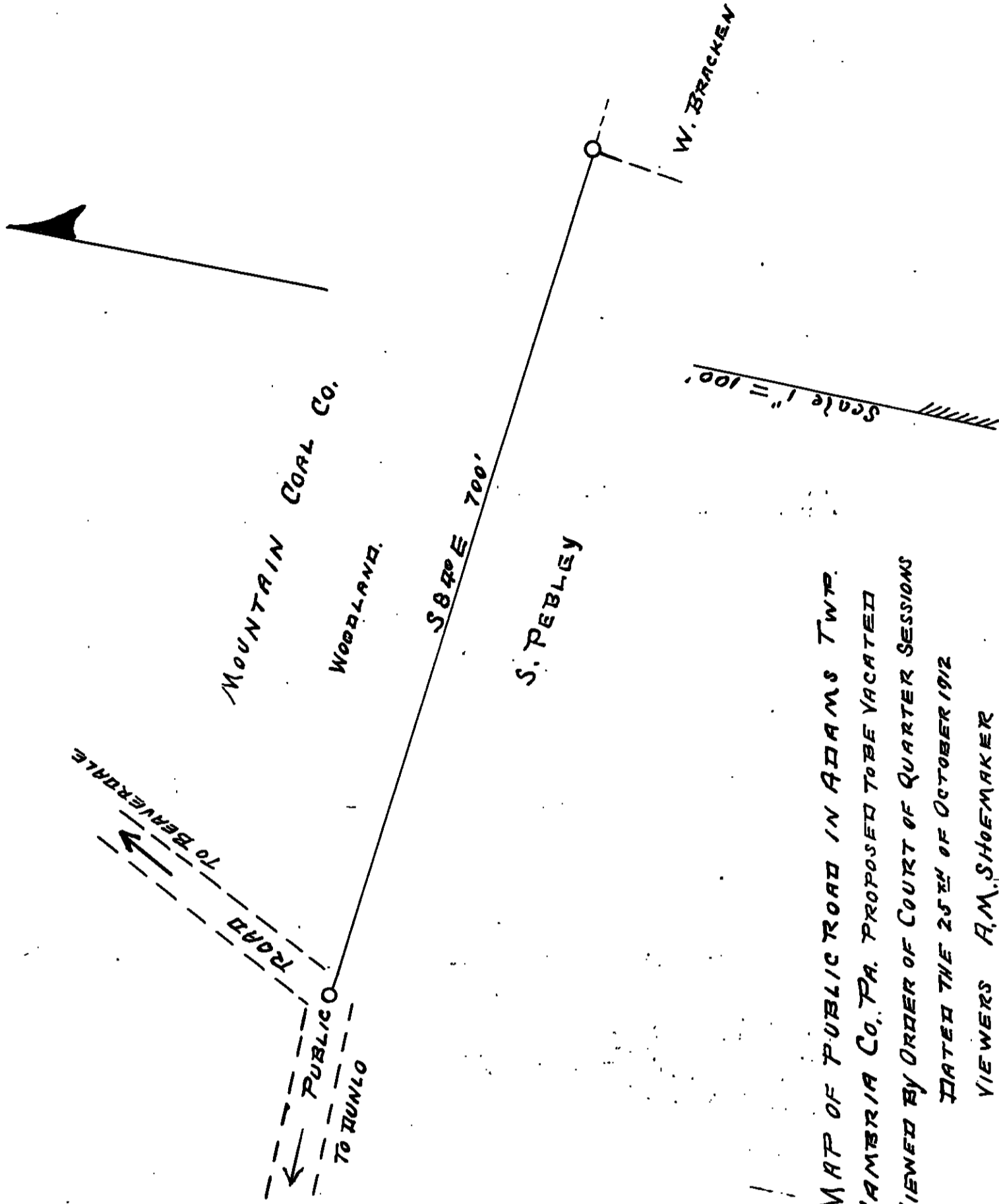

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Cambria held at Ebensburg, in the said County, on the 25 day of October A. D. 1902, before the Honorable Judge of the said Court: Upon the petition of divers inhabitants of the Township of Adams,

in the said County, setting forth that they labor under inconvenience for want of a Public road road or highway, to lead from the intersection with the Public road leading from Dunsda to Beaver Lake, at the residence of Samuel Pebley, and ending at or near the residence of William Shank, a distance of seven hundred thirty feet, and the same has become useless and the necessity for such highway no longer exists, owing to its being used no longer by the traveling public for other reasons.

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. The Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

A. M. Shoemaker Esq. surveyor, and John L. Singer, P. F. Campbell

viewers, to view the ground proposed for said road, and if they view the same, and shall agree that there is ^{no} occasion for such road, they shall proceed to ^{vacate} lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be as far as practicable, agreeable to the desires of the petitioners, and that they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through which it may pass.

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."
