

R E P O R T O F V I E W E R S .

TO THE HONORABLE M. B. STEPHENS, PRESIDENT JUDGE OF THE
COURT OF QUARTER SESSIONS OF CAMBRIA COUNTY:-

We the undersigned, Members of the Board of Viewers of Cambria County appointed by your Honorable Court to view and determine as to the propriety or necessity of vacating a portion or piece of road in East Carroll Township, Cambria County, Pa. and supplying the same with another piece of road between the points of beginning and ending of that portion proposed to be vacated as noted in the Order of Court hereto attached, respectfully report:-

That having given due notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the Viewers to the Commissioners of Cambria County and the Supervisors of the Township of East Carroll by having them accept service of notices hereto attached and to the traveling public by printed handbills posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the termini of the piece of road proposed to be vacated and supplied; All of us met in accordance with the notices so given and having been first duly qualified according to law to perform the duties of our appointment, faithfully impartially and to the best of our judgment and ability; we viewed the premises and are of opinion that a change in the road bed between the points of beginning and ending as noted on the attached order is necessary for the convenience and accommodation of the traveling public as the grade of that portion of the public road suggested to be vacated is exceedingly heavy and considerably in excess of what the law contemplates as the maximum grade on public highways where it is practicable to reduce the same.

A plot or draft showing the location of the piece of road

now in use and also, the location of the new stretch of road suggested to be opened for public use instead of that portion proposed to be vacated in hereto attached and made a part of this report; Showing the piece of road proposed to be vacated between the points of beginning and ending of the same as noted on the attached order as taking the following courses and distances:-
 North 00 degrees 45 minutes East 428 feet, thence North 12 degrees West 95 feet, thence North 29 degrees East 168 feet to the termini and the piece of road laid out and suggested to be opened for public use running from the last referred to termini South 33 degrees West 120 feet, thence South 50 degrees West 107 feet, thence South 40 degrees West 46 1/2 feet, thence South 16 degrees West 160 feet, thence South 13 degrees West 144 feet, thence South 33 1/2 degrees East 140 feet, thence South 31 degrees East 288 feet to the southerly termini as noted in the attached Order.

Having failed to secure a release of damages from William A. Farbaugh, through and over whose land the proposed new piece of road is laid out, we have assessed his damages at two hundred and four dollars.

 DATED DEC. 2. 1912

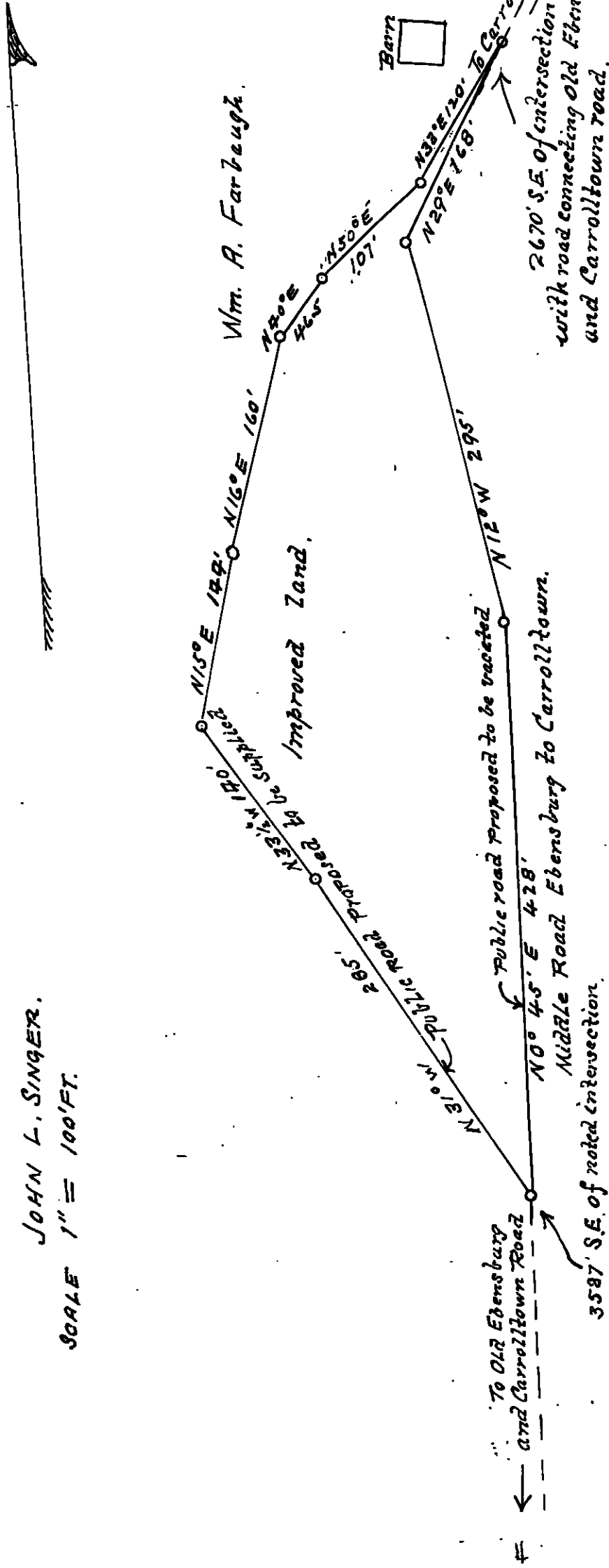

D. 19*12*, before the Honorable Judge of the said Court: Upon the petition of divers inhabitants of the Township of *East Carroll*.....in the said County, setting forth that they labor under inconvenience for want of a.....*public*.....road or highway, to lead from

Borough of Ebensburg to the Borough of Carrolltown as known as the Middle Ebensburg as Carrolltown Road, part of which they desire vacated as another laid out instead.....
.....They pray that that part of said public road, known as the Middle Road leading from the Borough of Ebensburg to the Borough of Carrolltown, in Cambria County, should be vacated from a point two thousand six hundred and seventy feet southeast of the point of intersection of said road with the connecting road between the middle.....Ebensburg as Carrolltown Road as the Old Ebensburg and Carrolltown Road, which intersection is about three miles from the Borough of Carrolltown, to a point on said road three thousand five hundred as eighty seven feet southeast of said intersection, all within the Township of East Carroll, County of Cambria, Pennsylvania, and a new road laid out from same point to same point at a proper grade and curvature and thus eliminate the dangerous and inconvenient part of present road.

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. The Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

viewers, to view the ground proposed for said road, and if they view the same, and shall agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be as far as practicable, agreeable to the desires of the petitioners, and that they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through which it may pass.

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."
