WHEREAS, the petition of certain of the inhabitants and citizens of the Township of Reade, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, has this day been presented to the Court of Quarter Sessions of the said County of Cambria, setting forth that they labor under some inconvenience by reason of the heavy grade and dangerous railroad crossings on the Philipsburg road leading from St. Augustine to Glasgow, at a point where said road intersects with the Cresson and Irvona Branch of the Pennsylvania Railroad, part of which they desire vacated and another laid out instead, and praying that that part of said public road leading from St. Augustine to Glasgow, in Cambria County, should be vacated from a point forty feet Southwest of the point where said public road intersects with the Cresson and Irvona Branch of the Pennsylvania Railroad, to a point two hundred and seventy feet North of the abovementioned point of intersection of said public road with said railroad, all within the Township of Reade, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, and a new road laid out from same point to same point at a proper grade and curvature and thus eliminate the dangerous and inconvenient part of the present road, and praying for the appointment of Viewers to vacate and supply the said road.
