Commissioners in session, Frank P. Hollern and John Thomas, Jr., present.


John Thomas, Jr., offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the County of Cambria is responsible for the construction or maintenance of the highway situate in the Townships of Blacklick and Jackson in the County of Cambria and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, leading from State Highway Route No. 54 in Blacklick Township at a point 32 feet east of culvert, said culvert being east of the intersection of the Township Route No. 11429, thence running in a southwesterly direction to the Borough line of the Borough of Vintondale, a distance of 3.122 miles, said road having a reinforced concrete surface.

AND WHEREAS, by Act approved May 28, 1943, being Act No. 333 of the 1943 Sessions of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, it is provided that where any County is responsible for the construction or maintenance of any highway, such highway shall, if and when the County Commissioners consent thereto by proceedings, a copy of which shall be filed in the office of the Courts of the proper County and with the Department of Highways, be adopted by the Commonwealth as a State Highway and shall thereafter be constructed, repaired and maintained at the expense of the Commonwealth as State Highways are now constructed, repaired and maintained under the provisions of existing laws.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED and it is hereby resolved by the Commissioners of Cambria County in regular meeting assembled that the consent of the Commissioners of Cambria County be and the same is hereby given to the adoption of the County road situate in Blacklick Township and Jackson Township, as heretofore described, by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as a State Highway.
