In the Matter of taking over portions of Beech, Third, and Stewart Streets in the Village of Lloydell, Township of Summerhill, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, said Streets appearing on a dedicated map or plot of the Village of Lloydell, aforesaid, same being of record in the Recorder's Office of Cambria County in Plat Book, Vol. 1 at page 167.

PETITION OF SUPERVISORS TO ACCEPT STREETS

To the Honorable, the Judges of said Court:

The petition of Roy H. Plummer, Frank Frank and Mickey Sibert respectfully represents:

1. That your petitioners are the duly elected, qualified and acting Supervisors of Summerhill Township, a Township of the second class of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

2. That on August 21, 1915, the Mountain Coal Company laid out a Plan of lots on certain of its property located in the Township of Summerhill, aforesaid, and described and called said Plan the " Plan of Lots of Lloydell, Summerhill Township ", and dedicated said Plan of lots to the public, causing the Plan to be recorded in the Recorder's Office of Cambria County in Plan Book, Vol. 1 at page 167, the date of recording the same being September 22, 1915.

3. That, among the streets appearing on said dedicated Plan of Lots, are Beech, Third and Stewart Streets.

4. That your petitioners feel that certain parts of Beech, Third and Stewart Streets appearing on said Plan of Lots should be accepted by the Township of Summerhill as Public Highways, being that part of said Streets indicated in " green " on the map hereto attached and forming a part of this petition.

5. That the parts of Beech, Third and Stewart Streets, which your petitioners feel should be accepted as Public Highways, comprise seven (7) blocks of a total length of Three thousand (3000) feet, having a width of Fifty (50) feet, and are described as follows:

Beginning on the southern line of Second Street, also known as Pennsylvania State Highway Route, No. 160, at its intersection with Beech Street, thence along Beech Street south 64 degrees 20 minutes west Three hundred (300) feet to the southerly side of Third Street; thence along Third Street North 25 degrees 40 minutes

west Twenty-three hundred (2300) feet to the westerly line of Stewart Street, said last mentioned Street being the Street separating the Villages of Beaverdale and Lloydell, afore-mentioned; thence along Stewart Street North 34 degrees 5½ minutes East Three hundred and fifty (350) feet to the northerly side of Second Street or State Highway Route, No. 160.

6. That the parts of the Streets desired to be accepted as Public Highways, described as above, are built upon on both sides, and the owners of property abutting thereon are greatly handicapped and inconvenienced by reason of the fact that said streets have not heretofore been accepted as Public Highways.

7. That attached to and forming a part of this petition is the petition of a large number of the leading citizens and abutting property owners of Lloydell, aforesaid, asking that the streets in question be accepted as Public Highways, marked Exhibit " B ".

8. That your petitioners have been advised that before said Streets can be legally accepted as Public Highways the approval of your Honorable Court must first be obtained.

9. That your petitioners, acting as the Board of Supervisors of Summerhill Township, on August 7th, 1938, by unanimous vote of the members taken at a Special meeting called for the purpose, of which all members had notice, passed a resolution accepting said parts of Streets as Public Highways of Summerhill Township, as appears by a copy of said resolution hereto attached and forming a part of this petition, appearing herein as Exhibit " C ".

Wherefore your petitioners pray that an order and decree be made approving and assenting to the acceptance of the parts of the Streets within described as Public Highways of the Township of Summerhill.




DECREE

And now, August 13th, 1938, the within petition having been presented, the same is read and considered, and the prayer thereof is granted, and the Court hereby consents to the acceptance of certain parts of Beech, Third and Stewart Streets, appearing on the Plan of Lloydell, Summerhill Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, recorded in the Recorder's Office of Cambria County, aforesaid, in Plat Book, Vol. 1 page 167, as Public Highways of the Township of Summerhill, aforesaid, being the parts of said Streets described as follows:

Beginning on the southern line of Second Street, also known as Pennsylvania State Highway Route, No. 160, at its intersection with Beech Street, thence along Beech Street south 64 degrees 20 minutes west Three hundred (300) feet to the southerly side of Third Street; thence along Third Street north 25 degrees 40 minutes west Twenty-three hundred (2300) feet to the westerly line of Stewart Street, said last mentioned Street being the Street dividing the Villages of Beaverdale and Lloydell, aforesaid, thence along Stewart Street north 34 degrees 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ minutes east Three hundred and fifty (350) feet to the northerly side of Second Street, or State Highway Route, No. 160; comprising seven (7) blocks of a width of fifty (50) feet.

Resolution

Whereas, the Mountain Coal Company laid out a Plan of Lots on August 21, 1915, on certain of its lands in Summerhill Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, describing it as a Plan of Lloydell, and on September 22, 1915, dedicated the Streets, lanes and alleys appearing thereon to public use by recording said Plan in the Recorder's Office of Cambria County, aforesaid, in Plat Book, Vol. 1 at page 167; and

Whereas, in the Judgment of the Supervisors of Summerhill Township, those parts of Beech, Third and Stewart Streets, appearing on said Plan, and described as follows: Beginning on the southern line of Second Street, also known as Pennsylvania State Highway Route, No. 160, at its intersection with Beech Street; thence along Beech Street South 64 degrees 20 minutes west Three hundred (300) feet to the southerly side of Third Street; thence along Third Street North 25 degrees 40 minutes west Twenty-three hundred (2300) feet to the westerly line of Stewart Street, said last mentioned Streets being the Street dividing the Villages of Leaverdale and Lloydell, afore-mentioned; thence along Stewart Street North 34 degrees 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ minutes east Three hundred and fifty (350) feet to the northerly side of Second Street or State Highway Route, No. 160; comprising seven (7) blocks of a width of Fifty (50) feet, - should be accepted as public Highways of Summerhill Township;

Now, therefore, be it resolved by Roy H. Plummer, Frank Frank and Mickey Sibert, Supervisors of the Township of Summerhill, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, that the parts of Beech, Third and Stewart Streets, described as above, be accepted as Public Highways of the Township of Summerhill, such acceptance, however, being made subject to the approval of the Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

Resolution moved by Mickey Sibert seconded by Frank Frank, and unanimously adopted by the Board of Supervisors of Summerhill Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, on this the 8th day of August, 1938.

Beaverdale, Pa., August 4, 1938.

To the Honorable Court of Cambria County—Greetings.

The undersigned property owners of the Township of Summerhill, village of Beaverdale, Cambria County, Penna. do hereby respectfully petition the Court of Cambria County to have the Road Supervisors of said Summerhill Township take over and maintain the following road in above said village of Beaverdale. This will be of great benefit to the community of said village on account of the unpassable condition of said road at times hampering property owners and citizens to a great extent in the delivery of their coal etc. and the going and from and coming to their homes.

Said road leading from State route #160 by way of Stewart street one block to Third street, thence up Third street to Beech street and by way of Beech street to connect again with State route #160.

The length of the proposed road is approximately 3000 feet.
