In the Matter of the Acceptance of certain
Streets on the Plan of Lloydell, Summerhill
Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

Petition of Supervisors for Approval of
Acceptance of Streets on recorded plan.

To the Honorable, the Judges of said Court:

The petition of Roy H. Plummer, Frank Frank and
Mickey Sibert respectfully represents:

1. That your petitioners are the duly elected,
qualified and acting Supervisors of Summerhill Township, a Town-
ship of the Second Class of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.
2. That on August 21, 1915, the Mountain Coal Company
laid out a Plan of lots on certain of its lands located in the
Township of Summerhill, aforesaid, said Plan being known as
"Plan of Lots of Lloydell, Summerhill Township," and same was
recorded on September 22, 1915, in the Recorder's Office of
Cambria County in Plat Book, Vol. 1 at page 167.
3. That certain of the Streets on said Plan have
already been accepted as public streets of the Township of
Summerhill, namely portions of Beech, Third and Stewart Streets
appearing thereon, as will appear by reference to Road Docket,
Vol. 7 at page 30.
4. That Lloydell is a built up portion of Summerhill
Township, and, in the judgment of the Supervisors thereof, the
streets on said Plan of Lloydell not heretofore accepted as
public highways of the Township should be accepted as public
highways of the Township.
5. That the streets proposed to be accepted as public
Highways of the Township are upwards of thirty-three (33)
feet in width.
6. That your petitioners, as Supervisors of the Township
of Summerhill, have adopted a resolution accepting the remaining
streets on said Plan of Lloydell as public streets of the
Township, subject to the approval of your Honorable Court, as
will appear by reference to the records of said Township, a copy
of said resolution, duly certified, being hereto attached and forming
a part of this petition.

Wherefore, your petitioners pray that an order and
decree be made approving and assenting to the action of your
petitioners in accepting the Streets on the Plan of Lloydell,
within referred to, as public streets, in accordance with the
Act of May 1, 1933, P.L. 103, Art. XI, as amended by the Act of
July 18, 1935, P.L. 1303, Section 2.

RESOLUTION

Whereas, the Mountain Coal Company laid out a Plan of lots on August 21, 1915, on certain of its lands in Summerhill Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, designated as "Lloydell", and on September 22, 1915, dedicated the streets, lanes and alleys appearing thereon to public use by recording said Plan in the Recorder's Office of said County of Cambria in Plat Book, Vol. 1 at page 167; and

Whereas certain of the streets appearing on said Plan, namely, parts of Beech, Third and Stewart Streets, have already been accepted as public streets or roads of the Township of Summerhill, as will appear by reference to Road Docket, Vol. 7 at page 30; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Supervisors of Summerhill Township, the remaining streets appearing on the Plan of "Lloydell", aforesaid, should be accepted as public Streets or Highways of said Township:

Now, therefore, be it resolved by Roy H. Plummer, Frank Frank and Mickey Sibert, Supervisors of the Township of Summerhill, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, that the remaining streets on the Plan of "Lloydell", not heretofore accepted, be accepted as public Streets or Highways of Summerhill Township, such acceptance, however, being made subject to the approval of the Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

Resolution moved by Roy H. Plummer seconded by Mickey Sibert, and unanimously adopted on this the 25th day of January, 1940,
