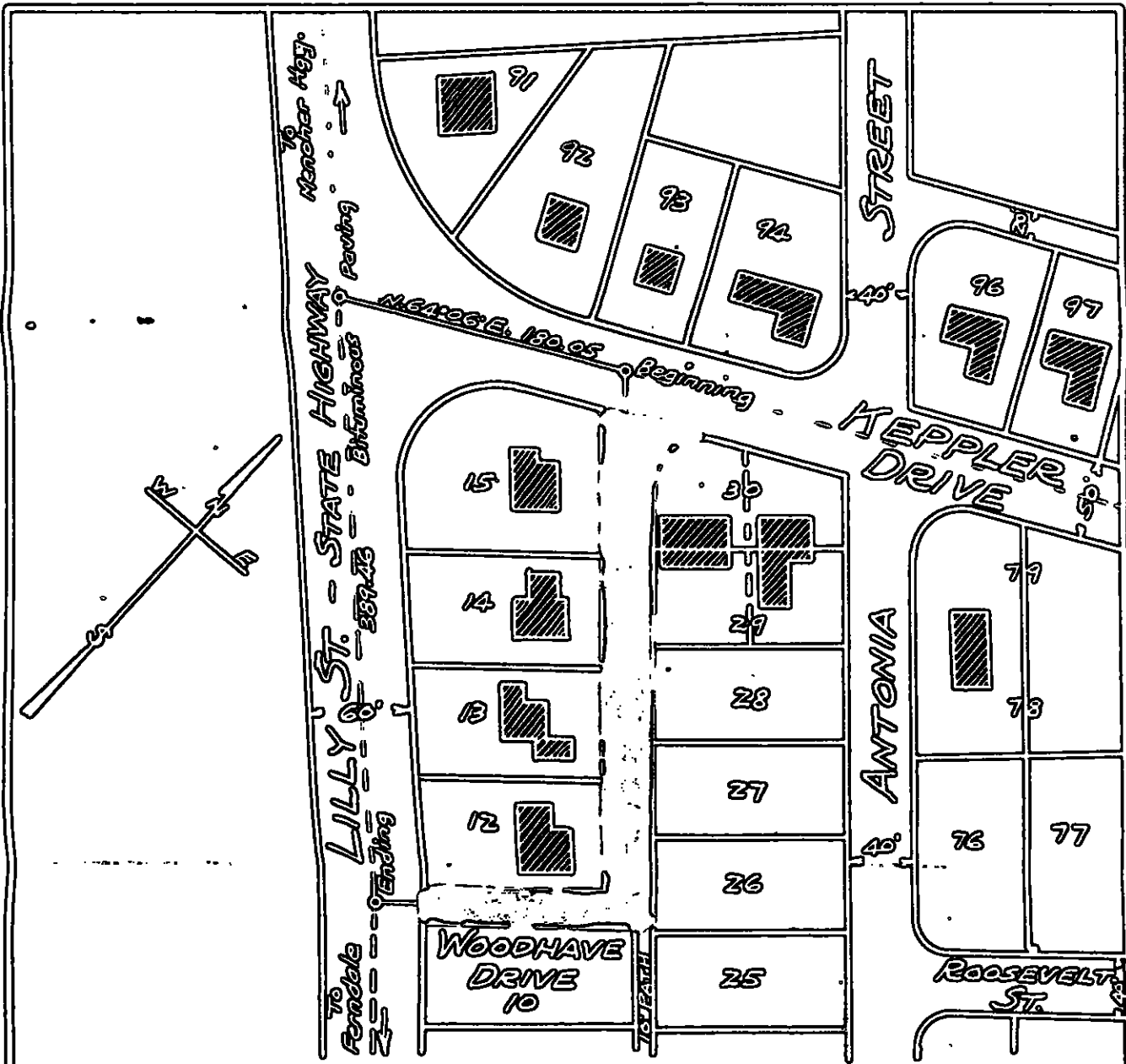

and James R. Graham, both of Upper Yoder Township, Cambria
County, Pennsylvania, are held and firmly bound unto the County of Cambria,
aforesaid, in the sum of FIFTY (50) DOLLARS lawful money of the United States
to be paid to the said County of Cambria, to which payment well and truly to be
made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, and every of
them, firmly by these presents. SEALED and dated the day of August,
1938.

WHEREAS, James R. Graham, et al, have presented a
Petition to the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania,
praying for the appointment of Viewers to view and locate the above mentioned
road in the said Township of Upper Yoder, to begin at the intersection of
Keppler Drive, a public road in said Township of Upper Yoder, and Cherokee Lane,
a dedicated highway thirty (30) feet in width, as shown on print hereto
attached and made part hereof; thence extending from the intersection of the
center line of said Keppler Drive with the intersection of the center line of
Cherokee Lane South $41^{\circ} 39'$ East a distance of three hundred thirty-five and
twenty-five hundredths (335.25) - - - - - feet
to the center line of Woodhaven Drive, a dedicated highway twenty (20) feet in
width; thence following the center line of said Woodhaven Drive South $50^{\circ} 3'$
West one hundred fifty-five and sixty-seven hundredths (155.67) - - - - -
feet to State Highway known as Lilly Street in the said Township of Upper Yoder.
The exact distance from the point of beginning of said proposed
road, measured from the intersection of the center line of said Keppler Drive
with the center line of said Cherokee Lane to the center line of said State
Highway known as Lilly Street is one hundred eighty and five hundredths
(180.05) - - - - -

feet; and the exact distance from the point of ending of said proposed road, as set forth in said petition, from an intersecting public road or street, to-wit, said Keppler Drive, measured from the point of the intersection of the center line of said Woodhaven Drive with the center line of said State Highway known as Lilly Street to the intersection of the center line of said Keppler Drive and the center line of said State Highway known as Lilly Street is three hundred eighty-nine and forty-six hundredths (389.46) - - - - - feet.

WHEREAS, the said Court has appointed Viewers for the purpose aforesaid;

NOW THE CONDITION OF THIS OBLIGATION IS SUCH that if the above bounden C. C. McLean and James R. REPORT OF VIEWERS

To the Honorable, the Judges of the above named Court,
we the undersigned Viewers, appointed by the annexed order of the
Court to view the proposed road within mentioned, respectfully
report:

That we have been duly sworn or affirmed as members of
the Permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County, as shown by the
records of the Court; that having given due public notice of the
time and place of meeting, by posting notices as required by law
along the route and at the termini of the said proposed new road,
as evidenced by copy of said notice hereto attached, and by
service of such notice on the County Commissioners of Cambria
County, the Supervisors of Upper Yoder Township through their
Solicitor, service of said notice by the County Commissioners and
the Solicitor for the Supervisors of Upper Yoder Township being
hereto attached; that one of the Viewers, S. E. Dickey, met in
accordance with the notice given on the 9th day of September A.D.
1938 at 2:00 o'clock P. M. (Eastern Standard Time); that several
residents of the Township were present, but on account of Messrs.
Baumgardner and McCann, the other two viewers, being unable to be
present, the view was continued to the 15th day of September A.D.
1938 at 1:30 o'clock P. M. (Eastern Standard Time); that in
accordance with said continuance, we met on the 15th day of
September A. D. 1938 at 1:30 o'clock P. M. (Eastern Standard Time)
and proceeded with the duties of our appointment and viewed the
premises and route of the proposed new road, that said proposed
new road is now opened and occupies dedicated highways, namely,
Cherokee Lane and Woodhaven Drive; that the public road proposed
to be opened, that is, Cherokee Lane thirty (30) feet in width

and Woodhaven Drive twenty (20) feet in width, is in a built up section in said Township of Upper Yoder, a second class township, therefore, being less than thirty-three (33) feet in width is of the type commonly known as an Alley and is not an intrical part of a through route; that the Viewers named herein and representatives of the Board of Supervisors and residents of the Township of Upper Yoder Township were present and heard during the view; no objections were made against the proposed road by the Supervisors or any residents of the Township of Upper Yoder; that the proposed road is situate in the Beechwood Section, strictly a residential section of Upper Yoder Township which is rapidly developing with a large number of houses now completed and under construction; that after viewing the premises and the route of the proposed road, we are of the opinion that a necessity exists for the proposed new road of a type known as an Alley, therefore, we proceeded to lay out same as follows: Beginning at a point in Keppler Drive, a public highway in Upper Yoder Township, N.64°06'E. 180.05 feet along the center line of Keppler Drive from its intersection with Lilly Street, a public highway, being a State Road leading from Ferndale to Mencher Highway; thence by the center line of Cherokee Lane, a dedicated highway thirty (30) feet in width, S.41°39'E. 335.25 feet to the center line of Woodhaven Drive, a dedicated highway twenty (20) feet in width; thence by the center line of Woodhaven Drive, S.50°03'W. 155.67 feet to the center line of Lilly Street, a State Highway aforementioned, the place of ending, said ending being an exact distance of 389.46 feet measured along the center line of Lilly Street in a southeasterly direction from the intersection of Keppler Drive, a public highway, the total length of said proposed road being 490.92 feet, all of which is shown colored green on the blue print attached hereto and made a part hereof.

That the Route of the proposed road as hereinbefore

mentioned follows dedicated highways and is through a plan of building lots, five (5) of which are now occupied with residents.

That after taking into consideration all the matters before us, we are of the opinion that the road as prayed for by the Petitioners and laid out by us is necessary and convenient and not burdensome to the taxpayers of Upper Yoder Township, therefore, we recommend that the prayer of the Petitioners be granted.

Inasmuch as the right of way required for said road is already dedicated as a highway and no additional width will be required from the adjoining property owners, we assess no benefits and no damages to any of the abutting property owners.
