TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE ABOVE-NAMED COURT:--

The petition of the Board of Road Supervisors of the Township of East Taylor, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, sets forth the following facts;

1. That, at a regular meeting of the Board of Road Supervisors of the Township of East Taylor, held on the *27th* day of *September* A.D., 1946, a resolution was adopted by the said Board of Road Supervisors to take over as a township road, subject to the approval of the Court of Quarter Sessions, that certain road or street located in the Park Hill section of East Taylor.

2. That the section or piece of road which is to be taken over by the Township of East Taylor, is fully described in the resolution of the Board of Road Supervisors, which is entered in the minute book of the said Board of Road Supervisors. A certified and attested copy of the said resolution is attached hereto, made a part hereof, and marked "Exhibit # 1." A map of the proposed highway is attached and marked "Exhibit # 2."

WHEREFORE, the petitioner prays your Honorable Court to consent to the taking over of the said road or street, as a township road, under the provisions of Section 1147 of the Act of July 18th, A. D., 1935, P. L. 1299, in order that such road of street shall be and become a part of the public highway system of the Township of East Taylor.

RESOLUTION

On motion of Hiram F. Ribblitt seconded  
by Gerard Page and duly passed, it was

RESOLVED, that the Board of Road Supervisors of East Taylor Township, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, accept as a public road or highway that certain section of road or street located in the Park Hill Section of the said Township of East Taylor:

BEGINNING at the intersection of Chestnut Street and Second Avenue as designated on the Plan of Park Hill, the said point of beginning being now a public or Township road, and being located, south 59 degrees no minutes west, a distance of 300 feet from the intersection of a public road leading from State Highway, Route No. 160 to Park Hill; thence, along the line of Second Avenue, 59 degrees 8 minutes west, a distance of 326 feet to the westerly side of Oak Street; thence, along the line of Oak Street, north 30 degrees 52 minutes west, a distance of 790 feet, to the intersection of Oak Street and an unnamed alley; the said road or street, which is hereby accepted by the said Township of East Taylor as a public highway, having a width of 40 feet.
