TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE ABOVE NAMED COURT:

The petition of the BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PORTAGE TOWNSHIP,
CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA respectfully represents:

(1) That upon petition of the residents and owners of lots abutting on portions of Jefferson Avenue, Martin Avenue, Luther Avenue and Center Street, avenues and streets heretofore not adopted by your petitioners, being dedicated avenues and streets in the said Township of Portage and part of the recorded Plan of the Martin Realty Company, which said Plan was recorded June 23, 1914 in the office of the Recorder of Deeds in and for Cambria County, in Plat Book, Vol. 1, Page 151; your petitioners accepted the said portions of the said Jefferson Avenue, Martin Avenue, Luther Avenue and Center Street, as public streets, avenues and/or highways, subject to the consent of this Honorable Court as more fully appears by Resolution of your petitioners hereto attached, made part hereof, and marked "Exhibit A."

WHEREFORE, your petitioners respectfully pray that your Honorable Court give its consent to the acceptance of said portions of Jefferson Avenue, Martin Avenue, Luther Avenue and Center Street, described in said Resolution hereto attached, as public streets, avenues and/or highways in the said Township of Portage.

ORDER

NOW, the 3rd day of March, 1947, the within petition having been read and considered, the Court hereby gives its consent that the following portions of JEFFERSON AVENUE, MARTIN AVENUE, LUTHER AVENUE and CENTER STREET, described in Resolution hereto attached, as "Exhibit A," being dedicated avenues and streets on the recorded Plan of the Martin Realty Company, which said Plan was recorded June 23, 1914 in the office of the Recorder of Deeds in and for Cambria County, in Plat Book, Vol. 1, Page 151, be accepted as public streets, avenues and/or highways, said streets and avenues being described as follows:

1. JEFFERSON AVENUE:- Beginning at the intersection of the said Avenue and Lakeview Street to the intersection of the said Avenue and Maple Street, a distance of 1,021.7 feet, more or less; running East and West.
2. MARTIN AVENUE:- Beginning at the intersection of Martin Avenue and Center Street to the intersection of said Martin Avenue and Beaverdale Road, a distance of 750 feet, more or less; running East and West.
3. LUTHER AVENUE:- Beginning at the intersection of the Beaverdale Road and Luther Avenue to the intersection of the said Luther Avenue and Main Street, a distance of 420 feet, more or less; running East and West.
4. CENTER STREET:- Beginning at the intersection of Wayne Avenue and Center Street to the intersection of Center Street and Martin Avenue, a distance of 320 feet, more or less; running North and South.

And it is further ordered and directed that the said portions of Jefferson Avenue, Martin Avenue, Luther Avenue and Center Street, forthwith be and become

a part of the highway system of the Township of Portage, Cambria County, and
be it still further ordered and directed that this proceeding be recorded in
the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

"EXHIBIT A"

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the abutting property owners and citizens of the Township of Portage have petitioned us, the Portage Township Supervisors, to accept, with the approval of the Court, certain portions of streets, avenues and/or public highways in the said Township as streets, avenues and/or public highways, which streets, avenues and/or public highways were laid out as streets and avenues on the Plan of the Martin Realty Company, recorded in the Recorder's Office in and for Cambria County, on June 23, 1914, in Plat Book, Vol. 1, Page 151; and

WHEREAS, the said petitioners and citizens of the Township of Portage, residing on portions of said streets, avenues and/or public highways which have heretofore never been accepted by the Township Supervisors, suffer great inconvenience by reason that the same have never been accepted as public streets, avenues and/or highways by the Supervisors of Portage Township; and

WHEREAS, it is now the intention and desire of the Supervisors of the said Portage Township to accept the hereinafter described portions of said streets, avenues and/or highways, known as Jefferson Avenue, Martin Avenue, Luther Avenue and Center Street, in pursuance to the Act of General Assembly of 1933, P.L. 103, Article XI, Section 1147, as amended by the Act of 1935, P.L. 1299, Section 2, and as further amended by the Act of 1941, P.L. 39, Section 1, and further amended by Act of 1943, P.L. 590 (53 P.S. Supp. 19093-1147), in such case made and provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the following portions of the said Jefferson Avenue, Martin Avenue, Luther Avenue and Center Street, heretofore adopted, approved and recorded be, and the same are hereby accepted by the Supervisors of Portage Township as Township streets, avenues and/or highways being described as follows:

1. JEFFERSON AVENUE:- Beginning at the intersection of the said Avenue and Lakeview Street to the intersection of the said Avenue and Maple Street, a distance of 1,021.7 feet, more or less; running East and West.

2. MARTIN AVENUE:- Beginning at the intersection of Martin Avenue and Center Street to the intersection of said Martin Avenue and Beaverdale Road, a distance of 750 feet, more or less; running East and West.

3. LUTHER AVENUE:- Beginning at the intersection of the Beaverdale Road and Luther Avenue to the intersection of the said Luther Avenue and Main Street, a distance of 420 feet more or less; running East and West.

4. CENTER STREET:- Beginning at the intersection of Wayne Avenue and Center Street to the intersection of Center Street and Martin Avenue, a distance of 320 feet, more or less; running North and South.

Motion for the adoption of the said portions of streets, avenues and/or highways made by Charles E. Wells and seconded by John Trimmer. Resolution adopted this 25 day of February, A. D., 1947.
